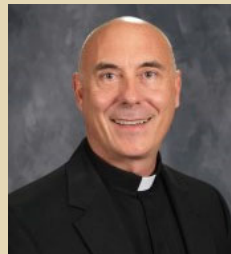

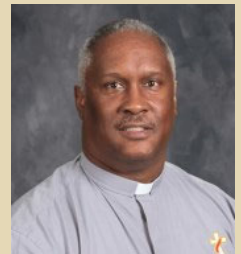

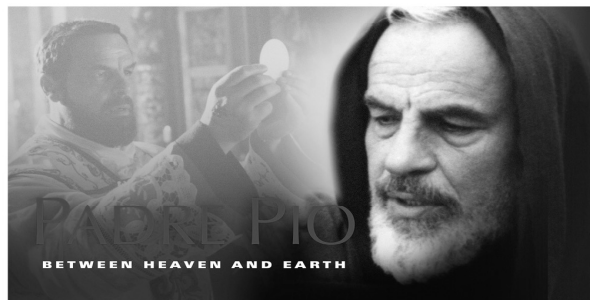

## **ADULT FAITH FORMATION with Fred Hack**

**HELP WANTED.** The parish is in need of Lectors, Sacristans, Ushers, and Altar Society members. Elsewhere in the bulletin, you are directed to my phone number if you are interested. I must advise you that Altar Society membership is actually a separate program. I must also advise that the pay is less than minimal but the retirement benefits are heavenly.

At our baptism we are given three extra jobs to share with Jesus - priest, prophet, and king. Prophets deliver God's messages, kinda like angels. No wings or halos

sorry to say, but an excellent opportunity to assist our priest in getting out the Word of God (Scripture) to our brothers and sisters in faith. Lectoring can be a challenge, an opportunity, a wonderful experience. Please don't let it slip away.

Sacristans help the priest offer the sacrifice (so do those who are in the pews) in a very "hands on" sort of way. Those who do such work usually spend an extra half hour in addition to the Mass. They prepare the altar, gifts (water and wine, and any bread needed) and other articles necessary for the perfect sacrifice such as the Missal and Lectionary. Please don't panic. Setting the books is a snap once you see the simple directions. Fire - the thurible in which we put the charcoal and father puts the incense - is the easiest of extra duties. But I'll save that for another time. Week-days are not much different than Sundays (and Saturdays), easier actually. Sundays can have helpers in the junior sacristans. Several of those juniors have graduated to full blown sacristans. Things like altar cloths, flowers, holy water, and cleaning fall under the Altar Society. They show up once a week and as needed. Gentlemen, it is a myth that only ladies can join. Check the bulletin for the contact person.

**PLEASE** take that first step and discover if any of these ministries are for you. Showing an interest will not get you unwanted emails, spam, telemarketers, even knocks on the door during supper. Thank you for taking a chance to help our faith community.

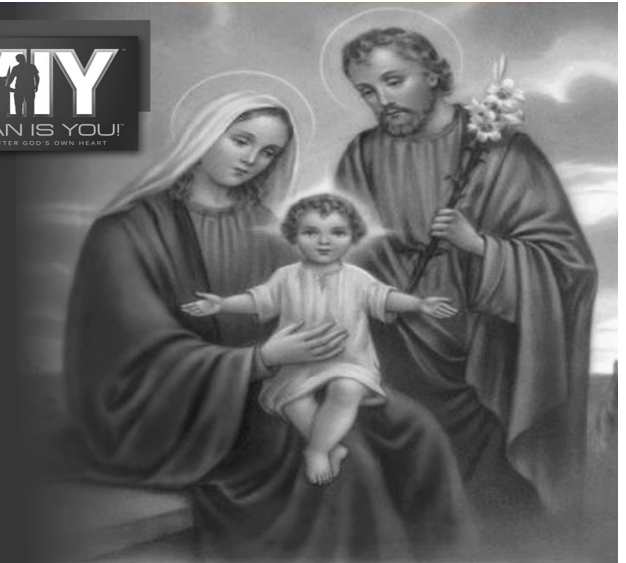
