



ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Are you seriously ill or having major surgery soon? Please contact the Parish Office and a priest will be notified.





#### **ADULT FAITH FORMATION with Fred Hack**

By way of getting prepared for Advent, and all of next year at the same time, be aware that we are starting Year C. So what does that mean? Well we have four Gospels: A = Matthew; B = Mark; and C = Luke. John appears every year usually during Lent and Easter time. So we leave Mark on November 27 and take up Luke on November 28, the first Sunday of Advent. It gets easier for weekdays, however. There we have Year I Year II. Odd years (2021) are Year I and even years (2022) are designated as Year II. Without getting complicated, just be

aware that "Year II" starts in 2022. The main reason it does not start with Advent is that the season has it's own readings. The same will happen during Easter time.

If you do not have a daily Missal, this may be relatively unimportant. If you attend daily Mass, you may feel the change. In your daily Missal, you will notice the difference in the tenor of the readings.

One last note. The first Monday after the first Sunday of Advent is our patron's feast day – no fasting, abstaining (Not that we do that as fervently as in the past) just celebrating. Hope to see you at that morning Mass in about six weeks. Oh, and keep listening to that Letter to the Hebrews on Sundays.
