THE FOUR WOES

I craved four things as a teenager: success in sports, food, fun and the attention of popular people. However, I noticed that as I acquired them, I was more unsatisfied than before. So, I'd strive even more energetically, achieve more, and the sense of emptiness was greater still. These four things started to feel like burdens or even curses. Soon after, I encountered Christ in my high school youth group. Experiencing his love was totally different than anything those four things previously produced. It produced a lasting happiness.

Jesus utters a kind of four-fold curse in this week's Gospel of Saint Luke's "woes": "Woe to you who are rich...who are filled now...who laugh now...who are well-spoken of" (cf. Luke 6:24-26). How marvelous that these correspond perfectly to the four things that obsessed my teenage soul: riches, food, laughter and good reputation. **The "woes" the Lord speaks are warnings: when those things are the purpose of your life, you'll be miserable. He is saying, "You'll be happy, or blessed, in the measure that these things do not determine the shape of our lives, and the kingdom of God does."**

To some degree, we're all spiritual teenagers, addicted to one or more of those four "woes." How splendid that the Lord wants his to bless us — that is, to satisfy us, make us laugh with joy, and in the kingdom of God, offer us what will truly satisfy us. But first let's admit what is causing our "woes."

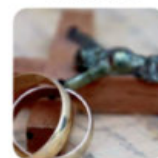

Stations of the Cross, Explained

In the earliest years of Christianity, the locations central to the story of Holy Week – the Garden of Gethsemane, Calvary, the Holy Sepulcher, and more – were destinations for pilgrims who wanted to experience Christ's sacrificial love for us in a physical way. In the years after the Crusades, pilgrimage to the Holy Land became impossible for most Christians, and the Stations of the Cross was popularized as a devotional means to pray through the passion and death of Christ.

Throughout history the number of stations has varied, with different traditions focusing on different events. In the 18th century, the number was officially fixed at 14 by Pope Clement XII. These stations are taken from the Gospel accounts of Christ's passion and death, though there are several which are derived from tradition and apocryphal sources, such as the meeting of Mother and Son and St. Veronica wiping the face of Christ.

ACTS OF GENEROSITY

When I was a child, I often thought of the Church as something mystical and supernatural. I wasn't wrong in my understanding of the Body of Christ, for surely the Church has these characteristics. However, even though we speak about the foundation of all we are as Church being the "mystery of Christ," Jesus became a man so that supernatural element could break into the natural world in a profound way. What we once could not see, we now see. What we saw as a God in a distant place now dwelt among us. It is one of the aspects of Catholicism that I have grown to appreciate the most as I have matured: for a Catholic, the supernatural is natural. The communion of saints is heavenly and earthly at the same time.

The Beatitudes instruct us about this reality. Pope Francis reminds us that holiness is "not about swooning in mystic rapture." **Holiness is about living in the real world and doing extraordinary things with our ordinary lives.** Our stewardship way of life consists of actions in the natural world that have extraordinary repercussions.

Do not ever take your simple actions of generosity and love for granted. As disciples called to a life of stewardship, we participate in something more profound than what we can see. We are blessed to be called to follow Jesus, and we bring blessing to all those with whom we choose to share ourselves.

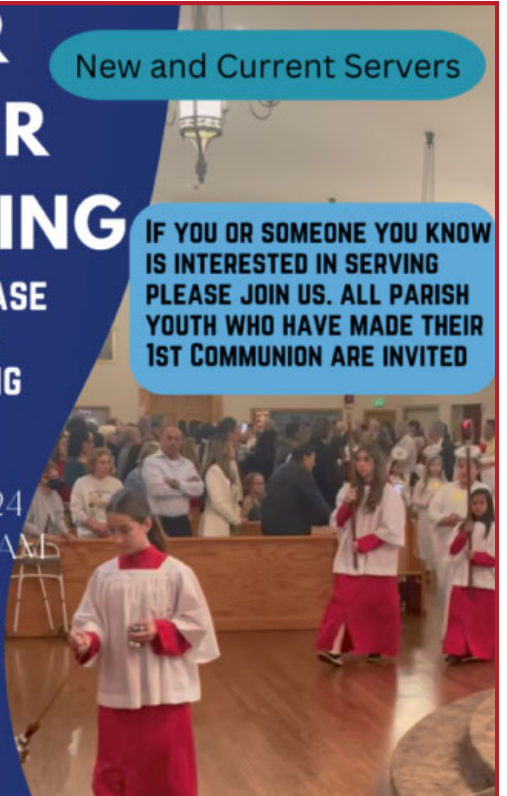

ACTOS DE GENEROSIDAD

Cuando era niño, solía pensar en la Iglesia como algo místico y sobrenatural. No me equivocaba en mi comprensión del Cuerpo de Cristo, pues seguramente la Iglesia tiene estas características. Sin embargo, aunque hablamos de que el fundamento de todo lo que somos como Iglesia es el "misterio de Cristo", Jesús se hizo hombre para que ese elemento sobrenatural pudiera irrumpir en el mundo natural de una manera profunda. Lo que antes no podíamos ver, ahora lo vemos. Lo que veíamos como un Dios en un lugar lejano ahora habitaba entre nosotros. Es uno de los aspectos del catolicismo que más he llegado a apreciar a medida que he madurado: para un católico, lo sobrenatural es natural. La comunión de los santos es celestial y terrenal al mismo tiempo.

Las Bienaventuranzas nos instruyen sobre esta realidad. El Papa Francisco nos recuerda que la santidad "no consiste en desmayarse en un éxtasis místico". La santidad consiste en vivir en el mundo real y hacer cosas extraordinarias con nuestra vida ordinaria. Nuestra forma de vida de corresponsabilidad consiste en acciones en el mundo natural que tienen repercusiones extraordinarias.

Nunca des por sentado tus simples acciones de generosidad y amor. Como discípulos llamados a una vida de corresponsabilidad, participamos en algo más profundo de lo que podemos ver. Somos bendecidos por ser llamados a seguir a Jesús y traemos bendición a todos aquellos con quienes elegimos compartirla.

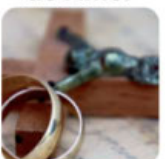

Estaciones del Vía Crucis, Explicadas

En los primeros años del cristianismo, los lugares centrales de la historia de la Semana Santa (el Huerto de Getsemaní, el Calvario, el Santo Sepulcro y más) eran destinos para los peregrinos que querían experimentar el amor sacrificial de Cristo por nosotros de una manera física. En los años posteriores a las Cruzadas, la peregrinación a Tierra Santa se volvió imposible para la mayoría de los cristianos, y el Vía Crucis se popularizó como un medio devocional para orar por la pasión y muerte de Cristo.

A lo largo de la historia, el número de estaciones ha variado, y las diferentes tradiciones se centran en diferentes eventos. En el siglo XVIII, el Papa Clemente XII fijó oficialmente el número en 14. Estas estaciones están tomadas de los relatos evangélicos de la pasión y muerte de Cristo, aunque hay varias que se derivan de la tradición y fuentes apócrifas, como el encuentro de la Madre y el Hijo y Santa Verónica limpiando el rostro de Cristo.

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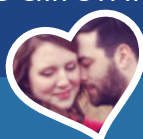
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
