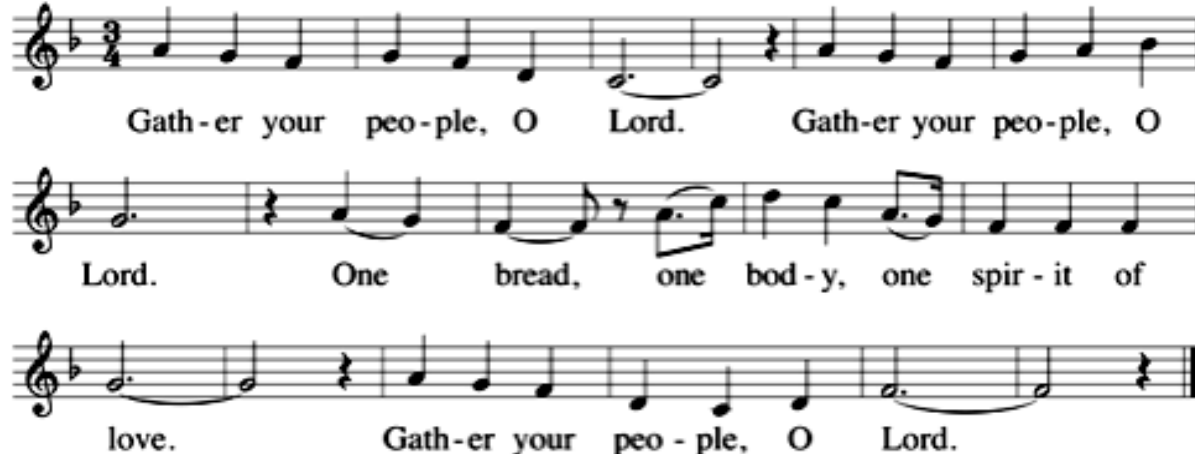

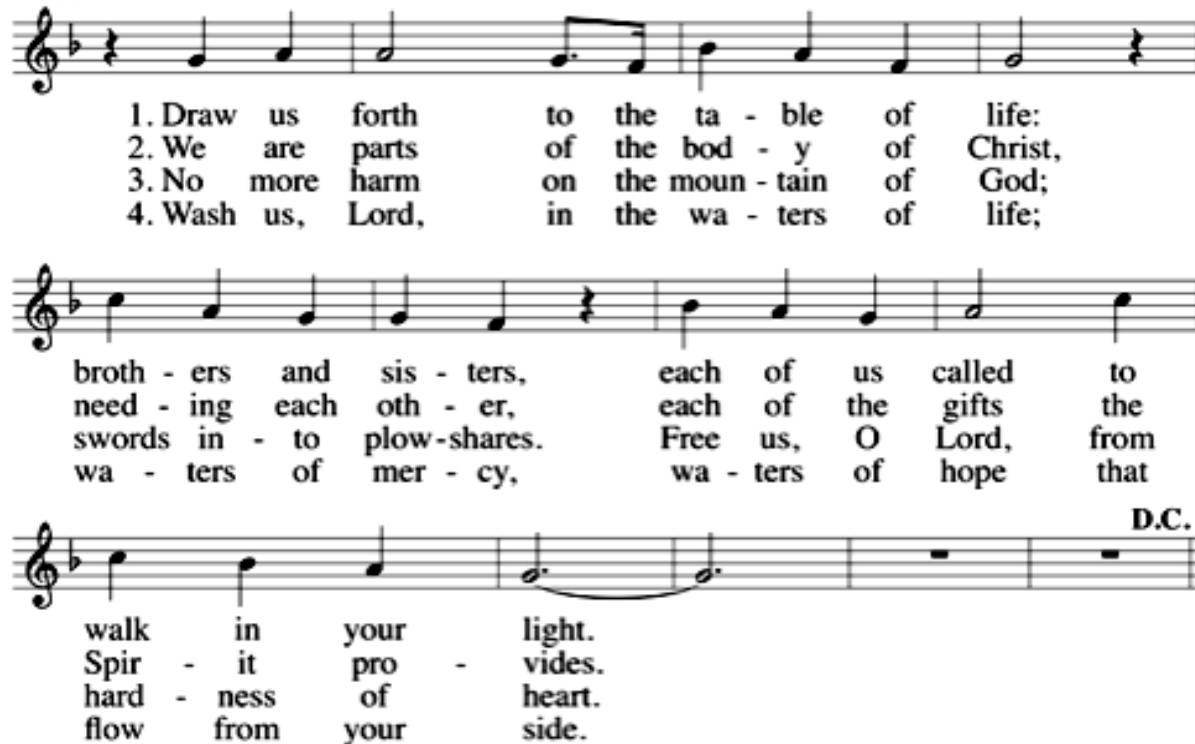

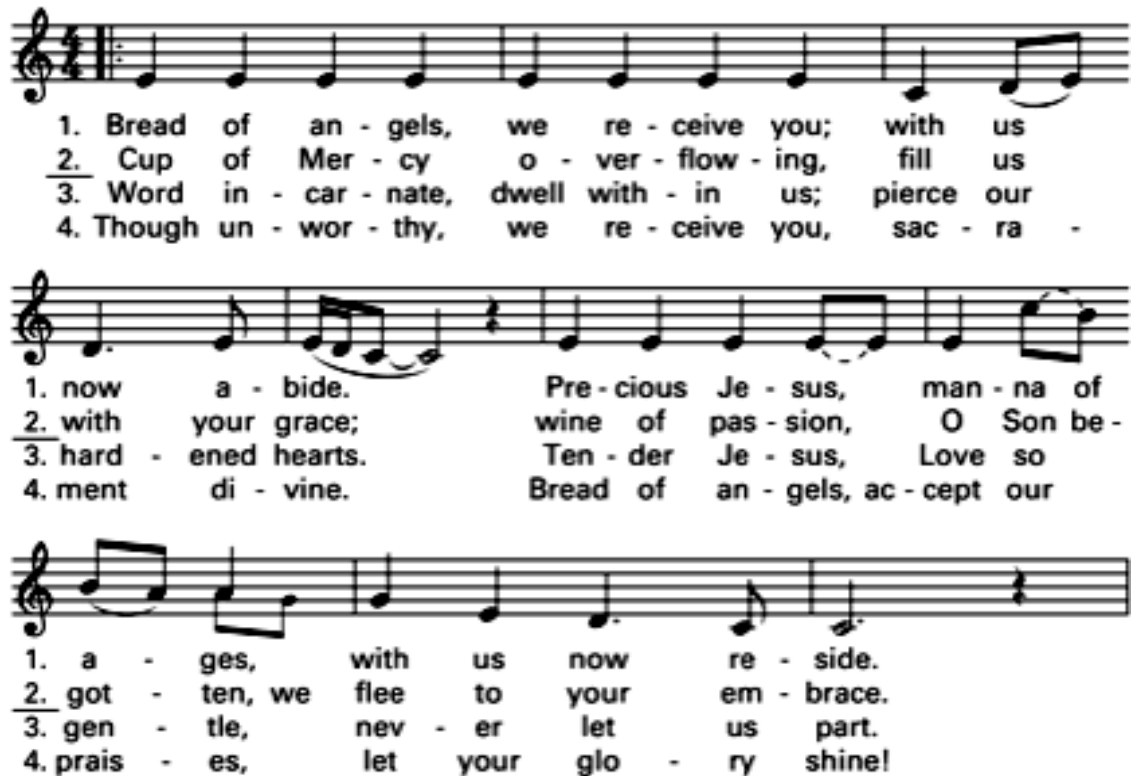

California Bishops Oppose CA Constitutional Amendment to Protect Abortion

SACRAMENTO, Calif. — California voters will have the opportunity to approve or reject a strongly pro-abortion amendment to the state constitution in November. The state's Catholic bishops said the proposal gives a "bound-less scope" to ending the lives of the unborn when human lives should instead be protected "at every age in every stage." The proposed amendment "looks to enshrine the most extreme forms of abortion into the California Constitution," the California Catholic Conference warned in a [statement](#) signed by the 12 archbishops and bishops leading the state's 12 dioceses and archdioceses. "This constitutional amendment, as written, will legalize and protect abortion up to the point just prior to delivery," the conference said. "It is distressing that so many California legislators would sign their names to legislation that allows the taking of a human life moments before birth." <https://cacatholic.org/article/california-bishops-oppose-ca-constitutional-amendment-protect-abortion>

Los Obispos de California se oponen a la enmienda constitucional de CA para proteger el aborto

SACRAMENTO, Calif. — Los votantes de California tendrán la oportunidad de aprobar o rechazar una enmienda fuertemente pro-aborto a la constitución estatal en noviembre. Los obispos católicos del estado dijeron que la propuesta otorga un "alcance ilimitado" para acabar con la vida de los no nacidos cuando, en cambio, las vidas humanas deberían protegerse "en todas las edades y en todas las etapas". La enmienda propuesta "busca consagrar las formas más extremas de aborto en la Constitución de California", advirtió la Conferencia Católica de California en una declaración firmada por los 12 arzobispos y obispos que lideran las 12 diócesis y arquidiócesis del estado.

"Esta enmienda constitucional, tal como está escrita, legalizará y protegerá el aborto hasta el punto justo antes del parto", dijo la conferencia. "Es angustiante que tantos legisladores de California firmen con sus nombres una legislación que permite quitarle la vida a un ser humano momentos antes del nacimiento".
