BISMARCK, N.D. —**Father Austin A. Vetter** has been appointed by Pope Francis as the Bishop of the Diocese of Helena, the Catholic diocese for western Montana. The appointment was announced on October 8th 2019 in Rome and at a news conference in Bismarck this morning. Father Vetter is only the second Diocese of Bismarck priest to be named bishop — the first native of North Dakota. Bishop David D. Kagan, Diocese of Bismarck, said of Fr. Vetter, "Thank God that he has the courageous faith to say 'yes' and be a shepherd of God's people. He will do very well and he will always be a credit to Christ and our Church and to his home diocese." Bishop-elect Vetter will be ordained and installed as the Bishop of Helena on Nov. 20, 2019 at the Cathedral of St. Helena. He takes over for Bishop George Thomas, who was appointed as the bishop of the Diocese of Las Vegas in February 2018. *-Diocese of Bismarck*

LET'S TALK ABOUT AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL

Since the summer in North Dakota is so short, we spend more of our time away, going to different parishes closest to our current location, and since our Winter is so terrible there are often times where we are unable to make it to Mass. However, just because our circumstances can change, the costs of running a large parish do not. Our collections are the only way we pay our heat, our water, and our very small staff. We could not be more appreciative of the efforts our parishioners have put into the pledge for our Church Restoration, but those funds are strictly for our Restoration and not for our day to day parish costs. Please consider signing up for Automatic withdrawal so you never miss an opportunity to give. There are Auto Withdrawal forms on each white table, and a printable form our Website. When you use automatic withdrawal our church does not incur a credit card processing fee. It gives you the freedom to choose the option of donating, once or twice month, or even once a quarter or once a year, and it frees up your time so you're not writing checks during Mass or trying to run to the bank after getting all of your children settled in the car.
