LITTLE FLOWER JOB OPENINGS

The parish has immediate openings for two individuals to fill their secretarial and bookkeeping positions. Both part-time positions, up to 30 hours/week, include benefits and require individuals who are active in their faith, have good communication, time management and organizational skills, prior office experience, and a strong knowledge of computer programs. The secretarial position will include receptionist duties, communicating with the publications staff, preparations of the church for weekend liturgies, maintaining sacramental, membership and offertory records, and a variety of duties that come up during the year in support of the pastor and parish ministries. The bookkeeping position will include accounts payable, managing bank accounts, generating financial reports, working closely with the Parish Finance Council, helping prepare the annual budget and other administrative duties in support of the pastor as needed. Ideally, the two individuals hired would cross train and share some common duties. 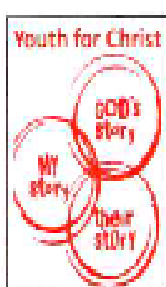
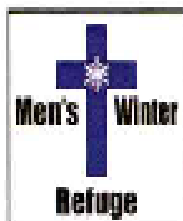
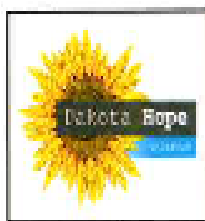
