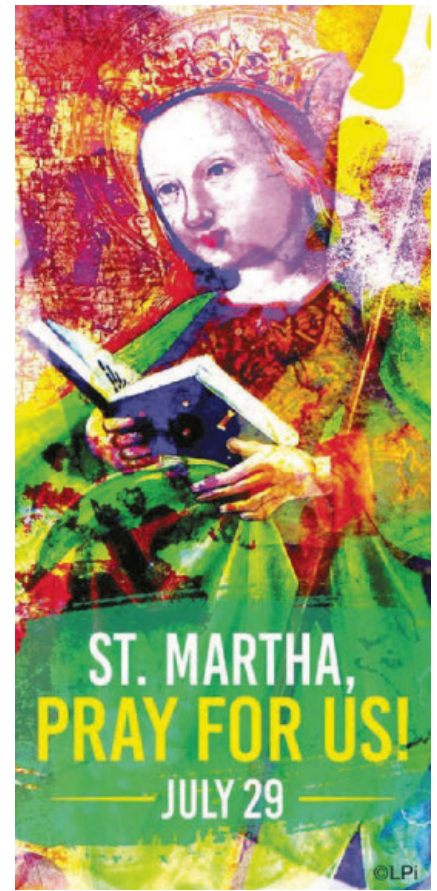

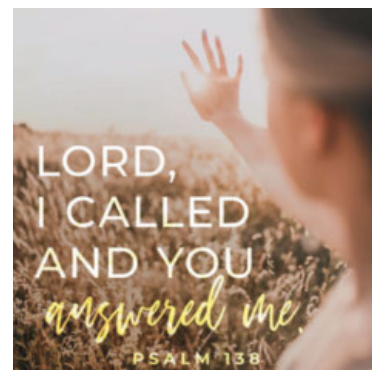


DIOCESAN MESSAGE
