Vocation: Helping Families Hear God's Call

On Monday, August 4th, the Church celebrates St. John Marie Vianney, the patron saint of diocesan priests. He is a shining example of what it means to live out a priestly vocation with deep faith and dedication. Known for his powerful preaching and tireless prayer life, he spent long hours each day in the confessional, offering mercy and healing to the people of Ars, France.

St. John Vianney became a priest because he listened for God's voice—and even when the path was difficult, he chose to follow. Sometimes God speaks clearly through signs; other times, He speaks in a whisper or gentle nudge. Either way, He invites us to say yes.

The word vocation means “a calling.” Every Christian shares a basic vocation: to love God and to love others as Christ has loved us. But within that universal call, some are called to serve in a unique and committed way—through marriage, religious life, or the priesthood. In marriage, you love your spouse. In religious life, you love your community. As a diocesan priest, you love and serve the people of your diocese.

It's important for all of us to begin asking God about our vocation early in life. We can ask Him to speak to us—whether through signs or nudges—and then, when the time comes, to give us the courage to take a step of faith.

As your pastor, I encourage every family in our parish to talk about vocations at least once a year. Maybe this article is the perfect reason to bring it up at the dinner table this week. Our children and young adults need to know that you will support them, no matter how God calls them—whether to married life, religious life, or the priesthood.

Here at St. Mark, we offer real opportunities for young men to explore the call to priesthood. If you're a teen or young adult, consider joining our Carlos Acutis Vocational Group. It's a simple, honest space where guys can talk openly about the priesthood and begin to discern where God may be leading them.

Let's ask for the prayers of St. John Marie Vianney, that more young people in our parish will have the clarity and courage to hear Jesus' call—and to follow Him joyfully into the priesthood or religious life.

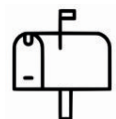

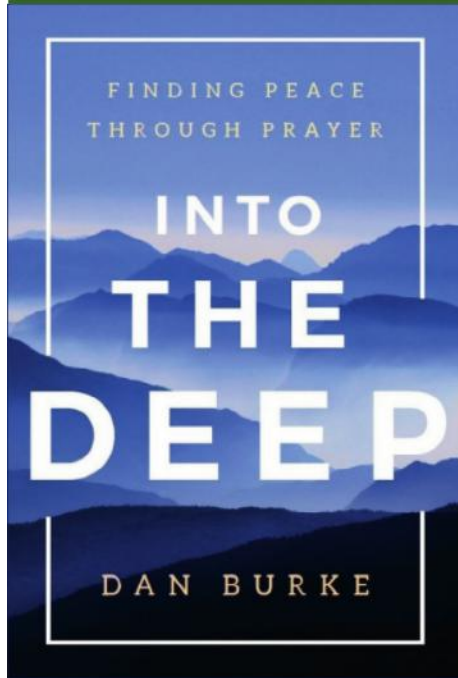
Young Adult Fall Bible Study

Vocación: Ayudando a las Familias a Escuchar el Llamado de Dios

El lunes 4 de agosto, la Iglesia celebra a San John María Vianney, patrono de los sacerdotes diocesanos. Él es un ejemplo brillante de lo que significa vivir una vocación sacerdotal con fe profunda y entrega total. Fue conocido por su predicación poderosa, su vida de oración constante y por pasar largas horas cada día en el confesionario, ofreciendo misericordia y sanación al pueblo de Ars, Francia.

San John María Vianney fue sacerdote porque escuchó la voz de Dios y, aun cuando el camino era difícil, decidió seguirlo. A veces Dios nos habla con claridad a través de señales; otras veces, lo hace con una voz suave y discreta. En ambos casos, nos invita a decirle que sí.

La palabra vocación significa "llamado". Todos los cristianos compartimos una vocación común: amar a Dios y amar al prójimo como Cristo nos ha amado. Pero dentro de ese llamado general, algunos son llamados a servir de una manera especial y comprometida—ya sea en el matrimonio, en la vida religiosa o en el sacerdocio. En el matrimonio, se ama al cónyuge. En la vida religiosa, se ama a la comunidad. Y como sacerdote diocesano, se ama y sirve al pueblo de la diócesis.

Es importante que, desde temprana edad, todos empecemos a preguntarle a Dios cuál es nuestra vocación. Podemos pedirle que nos hable—ya sea con señales o con suaves inspiraciones—y luego, cuando llegue el momento, que nos dé la valentía para dar un paso de fe.

Como su párroco, animo a todas las familias de nuestra parroquia a hablar de las vocaciones al menos una vez al año. Tal vez este artículo sea una buena razón para iniciar esa conversación en la mesa esta semana. Nuestros hijos y jóvenes necesitan saber que cuentan con su apoyo, sin importar cómo Dios los llame—al matrimonio, a la vida religiosa o al sacerdocio.

Aquí en St. Mark, ofrecemos espacios concretos para ayudar a los jóvenes a discernir el llamado al sacerdocio. Si eres adolescente o joven adulto, puedes unirte a nuestro Grupo Vocacional Carlo Acutis. Es un lugar sencillo y auténtico donde los jóvenes pueden hablar abiertamente sobre el sacerdocio y comenzar a discernir hacia dónde los guía Dios.

Pidamos la intercesión de San John María Vianney, para que muchos jóvenes de nuestra parroquia escuchen el llamado de Jesús y lo sigan con alegría en el sacerdocio o en la vida religiosa.
