SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Every year on August 15, we celebrate one of the Church's greatest feasts: the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On this day, we honor the beautiful truth that Mary, at the end of her earthly life, was taken up—body and soul—into the glory of heaven. Because of its importance, the Church calls this a Holy Day of Obligation, meaning that all Catholics are asked to attend Mass in thanksgiving for this gift.

Here are a few helpful questions and answers to deepen your understanding and appreciation of this great feast:

What is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary?

The Church teaches that *"The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory"* (Pope Pius XII, Munificentissimus Deus 44). This means that Mary did not experience bodily decay, but was taken into heaven whole and entire.

Did the Blessed Virgin Mary die?

The Church has never defined dogmatically whether Mary actually died. The Eastern Catholic tradition often speaks of her *"falling asleep"* (Dormition) before her Assumption. Still, many theologians believe that, since Jesus died, it would be fitting for His Mother to also experience death, uniting her even more closely to her Son in both suffering and glory. But the key point is this: Mary was assumed, body and soul, into heaven.

Are there early references to this belief?

Yes. As early as the 2nd and 3rd centuries, Christians wrote about Mary's Assumption in texts known as The Crossing Over of Mary. While these writings are not part of official Church teaching, they show that belief in Mary's Assumption was already present in the early Church.

How does this teaching matter in our daily lives?

The Assumption of Mary is not just about her—it's about our future, too. Mary has gone before us, showing us what awaits those who live in Christ. As Pope Benedict XVI said:

"By contemplating Mary in heavenly glory, we understand that the earth is not our definitive homeland, and that if we live with our gaze fixed on eternal goods, we will one day share in the same glory—and even the earth will become more beautiful." (General Audience, August 16, 2006)

Mary gives us hope. She reminds us that we are made for heaven, and that by following Jesus now, we too may one day share in His glory. Let us come together on August 15 to honor Our Blessed Mother, give thanks for her Assumption, and look forward with joyful hope to the life God promises us.

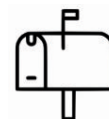

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA ASUNCIÓN DE LA SANTÍSIMA VIRGEN MARÍA

Cada año, el 15 de agosto, celebramos una de las grandes fiestas de la Iglesia: la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María. En este día, honramos la verdad maravillosa de que María, al final de su vida terrena, fue llevada al cielo en cuerpo y alma, a la gloria eterna. Por la importancia de este misterio, la Iglesia lo considera una Fiesta de Precepto, lo que significa que todos los católicos estamos llamados a participar en la Santa Misa para dar gracias a Dios por este don.

A continuación, comparto algunas preguntas y respuestas que pueden ayudarte a comprender mejor esta solemnidad:

¿Qué es la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María?

La Iglesia enseña que: *"La Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen María, al terminar el curso de su vida terrena, fue asunta en cuerpo y alma a la gloria del cielo"* (Pío XII, Munificentissimus Deus, 44). Esto significa que el cuerpo de María no conoció la corrupción, sino que fue glorificado y llevado al cielo.

¿Murió la Virgen María?

La Iglesia no ha definido oficialmente si María murió o no. En la tradición de las Iglesias Católicas Orientales, se habla de la Dormición de María, es decir, que se "durmió" antes de ser llevada al cielo. Sin embargo, muchos teólogos opinan que, si Cristo murió en su humanidad, sería adecuado que su Madre también haya pasado por la muerte, uniéndose aún más a Él en su pasión y gloria. Lo importante es esto: María fue asunta al cielo en cuerpo y alma.

¿Hay referencias antiguas sobre esta creencia?

Sí. Ya desde los siglos II y III, existen escritos llamados El Tránsito de María que mencionan esta creencia. Aunque estos textos no son doctrinales, reflejan que desde los primeros tiempos los cristianos ya creían en la Asunción de María.

¿Qué significa esta enseñanza para nuestras vidas?

La Asunción no es solo sobre María—es una promesa para nosotros también. María va delante de nosotros, mostrándonos lo que Dios tiene preparado para quienes viven unidos a Cristo.

El Papa Benedicto XVI dijo: *"Contemplando a María en la gloria del cielo, comprendemos que la tierra no es nuestra patria definitiva; y que si vivimos con la mirada puesta en los bienes eternos, un día compartiremos la misma gloria, y también la tierra será más hermosa."* (Audience General, 16 de agosto de 2006)

María nos da esperanza. Nos recuerda que fuimos creados para el cielo, y que si seguimos a Jesús, también nosotros participaremos de su gloria. Unámonos este 15 de agosto para honrar a nuestra Madre Santísima, agradecer su Asunción, y renovar nuestra esperanza en la vida eterna que Dios ha preparado para nosotros.
