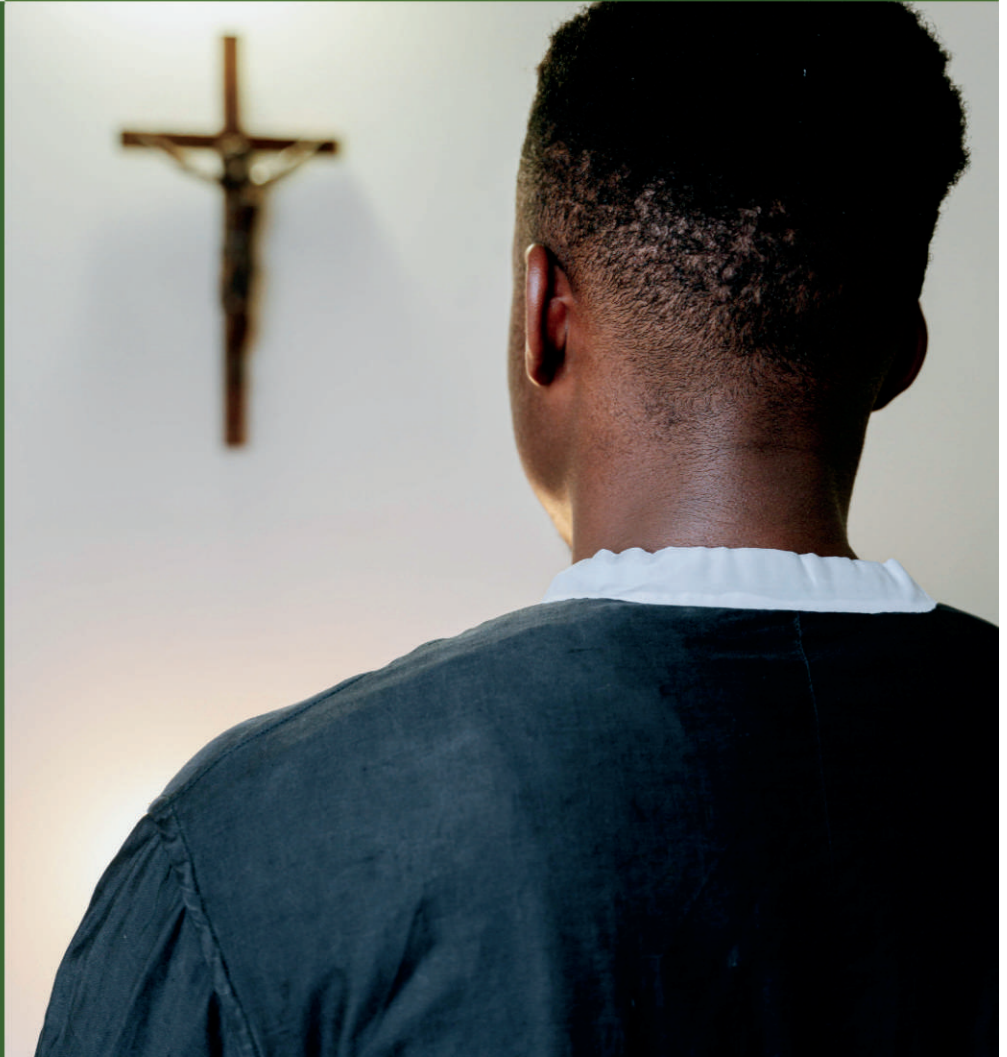

Do you actively grow in understanding your faith? Are you engaged in Scripture, in study, or spiritual reading?

Is Jesus the King of your work?

Do your actions in the workplace reflect your discipleship? Or have you compromised your integrity for convenience or gain?

Is Jesus the King of your money?

Do you give generously to support the mission of the Church and to help those in need? Or is giving an afterthought?

Is Jesus the King of your time?

Do you set aside time for prayer each day, or does everything else come first?

Is Jesus the King of your conversations?

Do your words lift others up? Do your conversations reflect the presence of God in your life—or do they stay stuck in worldly things?

Each of us has been made a **citizen of Christ's Kingdom** through baptism. That's the Good News—because **Jesus is a good King**. He knows us, loves us, and desires our fullness of life. But citizenship in His Kingdom is not passive. We must choose to live under His reign each day.
