## Epiphany

Today is the Epiphany of the Lord Jesus Christ. We meditate on the plan of God is revealed through the light of Jesus Christ. Thus, we have extra candles in the Church to remind us of the Light of the Gentiles. We focus on three mysteries in particular.

R

- Adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi: When the Magi come they bring gifts of Frankincense, Myrrh, and Gold. These gifts are fitting for a priest, a prophet, and a king. Myrrh also is a burial spice which prefigures Jesus' death on Calvary.

N

- Baptism of Jesus Christ: At his Baptism in the River Jordan, Jesus Christ is revealed to us as God and reveals that God truly is a communion of persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

E

- Wedding feast at Cana: Moreover, at the wedding feast of Cana, when Jesus changes the water into wine, he prefigures for us what he will institute on the last day of his life at the Last Supper; the Eucharist, where the bread and wine is turned into His Body and Blood.

R

We reflect how God has revealed himself to us and shown us his power, love, and goodness. Take some time to remember the moments that you have encountered God and give thanks to Him!

Finally, there are two traditions that we have during Epiphany. First, we announce the days of Ash Wednesday, Easter Sunday and the rest of the Church calendar. This year, Ash Wednesday will occur on February 18 and Easter Sunday on April 5. Second, on this day, we encourage the head of the houses to write the Epiphany Blessing on the mantel of their door with blessed chalk. This year it should read 20+C+M+B+26.

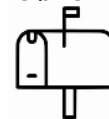

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## Epifanía

La fiesta de hoy celebra la Epifanía del Señor Jesucristo; la revelación del plan salvífico de Dios que se nos revela a través de Jesucristo. Como la luz ilumina las tinieblas, tenemos velas adicionales alrededor del altar para recordarnos que Jesús es la luz del mundo. Hoy pensamos en todas las formas en que Dios nos revela su plan, pero nos concentramos en tres misterios en particular: La adoración del Niño Jesús por los Reyes Magos, el Bautismo de Jesucristo y las bodas de Caná. En cada uno de estos momentos, recibimos una visión de la naturaleza de Jesucristo y de su misión de salvar al mundo.

- Cuando llegan los Magos, traen regalos de incienso, mirra y oro. Estos regalos son apropiados para un sacerdote, un profeta y un Rey. El incienso es utilizado por el sacerdote en el templo durante las ofrendas sacrificiales. La mirra es una especia funeraria. Se dice que la muerte es la recompensa de los profetas. Esta mirra prefiguraba la muerte de Jesús en el Calvario. El oro es el regalo de un rey

- En su bautismo en el Jordán, Jesucristo, que no necesitaba ser bautizado, se une a todos los que necesitamos la gracia del bautismo. Nos muestra así el camino de la salvación. Se nos revela como Dios y nos revela que Dios es verdaderamente una comunión de personas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

- Además, en las bodas de Caná, cuando Jesús transforma el agua en vino, nos prefigura lo que instituirá el último día de su vida en la Última Cena. En esta primera Eucaristía, Jesús convirtió el pan y el vino en su Cuerpo y su Sangre. En cada Misa, hace lo mismo para que podamos comulgar con Él. Esta santa unión es la razón, la fuente y la meta de nuestra fe Cristiana.

Este año, el Miércoles de Ceniza será el 18 de febrero y el Domingo de Pascua el 5 de abril. Segundo, en este día animamos a la cabeza de la familia a escribir la bendición de la Epifanía en el dintel de la puerta de su casa con tiza bendita. Este año debe decir: 20+C+M+B+26.

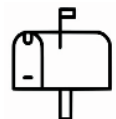
