Pope Paul VI tells us in *Humanae Vitae* that marriage “is in reality the wise and provident institution of God, the Creator, whose purpose was to effect in man His loving design.” In other words, marriage wasn’t dreamed up by Hallmark, Hollywood, or even your in-laws. Marriage comes straight from the heart of God. Jesus Himself makes that very clear in the Gospel of Matthew when He says, “What God has joined together, no human being must separate.” Marriage isn’t just a legal agreement or a romantic arrangement; it’s a covenant with God. That’s why the Church dares to call it a sacrament.

The desire for marriage is stitched into the human heart. Every one of us longs for communion. We want someone who truly knows us, accepts us, tells us the truth, and loves us anyway. That desire isn’t an accident. It comes from who we are. We are made in the image and likeness of God, and God Himself is a communion of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In other words, relationship is God’s idea. That’s why being alone forever never quite satisfies the human heart.

For most people, this longing finds its home in marriage. Scripture puts it beautifully and simply: “For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.” Not roommates. Not temporary partners. One flesh: heart, body, soul, and life together.

That’s why today we need to encourage our young people to pray seriously about the vocation of marriage, to prepare for it, and, if God calls them to it, to enter it with joy, generosity, and openness to life. Yet our culture often offers a different vision. Many are comfortable with “free unions,” where a man and woman live together without commitment or sacrament. Usually this isn’t about romance; it’s about fear; fear of permanence, fear of sacrifice, fear of fully giving oneself. Others are told that career success or personal fulfillment must come first, and family can wait... or maybe not happen at all.

And yet, standing quietly among us, we have the best argument for God’s plan: married couples who have lived their vows for decades. Couples who have loved through sickness and health, good times and hard times. Couples who now delight not only in their children, but in their grandchildren. They are living proof that God knew what He was doing when He said, “the two shall become one.” And for that witness, we give thanks.

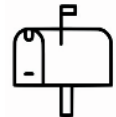

El Papa Pablo VI nos dice en *Humanae Vitae* que el matrimonio “es, en realidad, la sabia y providente institución de Dios, el Creador, cuyo propósito fue realizar en el hombre su designio amoroso”. En otras palabras, el matrimonio no fue inventado por Hallmark, Hollywood, ni siquiera por tus suegros. El matrimonio viene directamente del corazón de Dios. Jesús mismo lo deja clarísimo en el Evangelio de Mateo cuando dice: “Lo que Dios ha unido, que no lo separe el hombre”. El matrimonio no es solo un acuerdo legal o un arreglo romántico; es una alianza con Dios. Por eso la Iglesia católica se atreve a llamarlo un sacramento.

El deseo de casarse está tejido en el corazón humano. Cada uno de nosotros anhela comunión. Queremos a alguien que de verdad nos conozca, nos acepte, nos diga la verdad y aún así nos ame. Ese deseo no es un accidente. Proviene de lo que somos. Fuimos creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios, y Dios mismo es una comunión de personas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. En otras palabras, la relación es idea de Dios. Por eso, estar solo para siempre nunca termina de satisfacer el corazón humano.

Para la mayoría de las personas, este anhelo encuentra su hogar en el matrimonio. La Sagrada Escritura lo expresa de manera hermosa y sencilla: “Por eso el hombre dejará a su padre y a su madre, se unirá a su mujer, y los dos serán una sola carne”. No compañeros de cuarto. No socios temporales. Una sola carne: corazón, cuerpo, alma y vida, juntos.

Por eso hoy necesitamos animar a nuestros jóvenes a orar seriamente sobre la vocación del matrimonio, a prepararse para ella y, si Dios los llama, a abrazarla con alegría, generosidad y apertura a la vida. Sin embargo, nuestra cultura a menudo ofrece una visión diferente. Muchos se sienten cómodos con las “uniones libres”, donde un hombre y una mujer conviven sin compromiso ni sacramento. Por lo general, esto no se trata de romance; se trata de miedo: miedo a la permanencia, miedo al sacrificio, miedo a entregarse por completo. A otros se les dice que el éxito profesional o la realización personal deben ir primero, y que la familia puede esperar... o quizá no suceder nunca.

Y, sin embargo, silenciosamente entre nosotros, tenemos el mejor argumento a favor del plan de Dios: matrimonios que han vivido sus votos durante décadas. Parejas que han amado en la salud y en la enfermedad, en los buenos y en los malos momentos. Parejas que ahora se alegran no solo por sus hijos, sino también por sus nietos. Son prueba viva de que Dios sabía lo que hacía cuando dijo: “los dos serán una sola carne”. Y por ese testimonio, damos gracias.

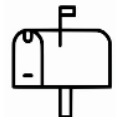
