Have you forgiven yourself?

O

That shameful thing you did days ago or maybe years ago. Have you forgiven yourself?

When we talk about forgiveness, we usually think first about God forgiving us through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Or we think about our responsibility to forgive the people who have hurt us. Both of those are essential. But there is another kind of forgiveness that is often forgotten and just as necessary, forgiving ourselves.

R

Forgiveness is at the heart of love, and love is the core of Christianity. Jesus tells us to love God with all our heart, mind, and soul, and to love our neighbor as ourselves. If we read that commandment through the lens of forgiveness, it might sound like this:

Allow God to forgive your whole heart, mind, and soul, and forgive your neighbor as you forgive yourself.

As a priest, I often hear someone come to confession and confess a sin from many years ago. They will say, "Father, I have confessed this before, but I do not feel forgiven." The truth is that they have already been forgiven by God, completely and definitively, the very first time they confessed that sin sincerely. What is missing is not God's mercy, but their own acceptance of it. They have not yet forgiven themselves.

E

Forgiving ourselves means coming to terms with the truth that we are not perfect. It means acknowledging that we have been wounded, sometimes deeply, and that at times we responded to those wounds in ways that hurt ourselves or others. Self-forgiveness requires humility, the courage to look honestly at the ugliness of sin while also recognizing that we are far more than our sin. And mysteriously, God can even bring grace and goodness out of our brokenness.

R

Once God has forgiven us in personal prayer and in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, it is good and even necessary to forgive ourselves.

We forgive ourselves much the same way we forgive others. We ask God for the grace to forgive. Then we claim that forgiveness, even speaking it aloud if necessary: "With God's help, I forgive myself for what I did." We can imagine Jesus gently taking that woundedness from our hearts and holding it in His pierced hands. Over time, healing comes, and freedom follows.

So if your answer to the opening question was no, then let today be the day.

Let us forgive today.

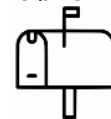

¿Te has perdonado?

O Esa cosa vergonzosa que hiciste hace días, o tal vez hace años. ¿Te has perdonado? Cuando hablamos del perdón, por lo general pensamos primero en Dios perdonándonos a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación. O pensamos en nuestra responsabilidad de perdonar a las personas que nos han herido. Ambas cosas son esenciales. Pero hay otro tipo de perdón que a menudo se olvida y que es igual de necesario: perdonarnos a nosotros mismos.

R El perdón está en el corazón del amor, y el amor es el núcleo del cristianismo. Jesús nos dice que amemos a Dios con todo nuestro corazón, mente y alma, y que amemos a nuestro prójimo como a nosotros mismos. Si leemos ese mandamiento a través de la lente del perdón, podría sonar así:

N Deja que Dios perdone por completo tu corazón, tu mente y tu alma, y perdona a tu prójimo como te perdonas a ti mismo.

E Como sacerdote, a menudo escucho a alguien venir a confesarse y confesar un pecado de hace muchos años. Dirán: “Padre, ya he confesado esto antes, pero no me siento perdonado”. La verdad es que ya han sido perdonados por Dios, completa y definitivamente, la primera vez que confesaron ese pecado con sinceridad. Lo que falta no es la misericordia de Dios, sino su propia aceptación de ella. Todavía no se han perdonado a sí mismos.

R Perdonarnos a nosotros mismos significa aceptar la verdad de que no somos perfectos. Significa reconocer que hemos sido heridos, a veces profundamente, y que en ocasiones respondimos a esas heridas de maneras que nos hicieron daño a nosotros o a otros. El perdón a uno mismo requiere humildad: el valor de mirar con honestidad la fealdad del pecado y, al mismo tiempo, reconocer que somos mucho más que nuestro pecado. Y, misteriosamente, Dios incluso puede sacar gracia y bondad de nuestra fragilidad.

Una vez que Dios nos ha perdonado en la oración personal y en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, es bueno e incluso necesario perdonarnos a nosotros mismos.

Nos perdonamos a nosotros mismos de manera muy similar a como perdonamos a los demás. Pedimos a Dios la gracia de perdonar. Luego acogemos ese perdón, incluso diciéndolo en voz alta si es necesario: “Con la ayuda de Dios, me perdono por lo que hice”. Podemos imaginar a Jesús tomando con ternura esa herida de nuestro corazón y sosteniéndola en sus manos traspasadas. Con el tiempo, llega la sanación, y después, la libertad.

Así que, si tu respuesta a la pregunta inicial fue no, que hoy sea el día.

Perdonemos hoy.

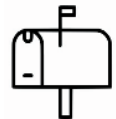


