C A R G O ' S

Did you know that we are made to give?

O

When God created you and me, He placed within us a deep desire to create, to produce, to nourish, and to love. All of these are expressions of giving. In fact, they reflect who God is. God is a giver. He creates generously, loves abundantly, and pours Himself out without measure.

R

There is a powerful image that helps us understand this truth: the Sea of Galilee and the Dead Sea. The Sea of Galilee is full of life—fish, vegetation, and thriving ecosystems. The Dead Sea, on the other hand, lives up to its name. It contains almost no life beyond a few bacteria and fungi. Why the difference?

N

Both seas receive water from the Jordan River. But only one gives water away. The Sea of Galilee receives and releases. Because it gives, its waters remain fresh and life-giving. The Dead Sea only receives. With no outlet, the water becomes stagnant and salty, unable to sustain life.

E

You and I are like these bodies of water.

God is constantly giving to us: life, talents, opportunities, relationships, and grace. He gives to us directly, and He gives to us through other people. But if we only receive and never give back, something begins to happen within us. Our hearts become “salty.” Joy fades. Life withers.

R

But when we give—when we intentionally return a portion of what we have received—our lives will flourish and sometimes in the most unexpected ways.

That’s why I want to invite you to consider giving back to God, intentionally and gratefully, a percentage of your income. Scripture speaks of the tithe, 10%, and many people can testify to the deep blessings that flow from that commitment. But everyone can begin somewhere. The key is intentionality.

For example, if you earn \$50,000 a year, 5% would be \$2,500. Or, if percentages feel overwhelming, you might offer God the first couple of hours of work each week as an act of gratitude.

In doing this, we are not “losing” anything. We are returning to God a portion of what He has already given us. That gift can support the parish, a particular charity, or the Diocese of Dallas. And one of the beautiful things is that we can ask God to guide us—to show us where our gift is needed most.

Yes, the parish needs resources to carry out its mission. But even more deeply, we need to give. It’s part of how God made us. It’s where freedom grows. It’s where joy comes alive.

So during these final days of Lent and as we enter the joy of Easter, I invite you to join me in discovering new ways to give—freely, intentionally, and joyfully.

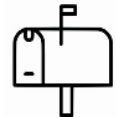

¿Sabías que estamos hechos para dar?

O Cuando Dios te creó a ti y a mí, puso dentro de nosotros un profundo deseo de crear, producir, nutrir y amar. Todas estas son expresiones de entrega. De hecho, reflejan quién es Dios. Dios es generoso. Él crea con generosidad, ama en abundancia y se entrega sin medida.

R Hay una imagen poderosa que nos ayuda a comprender esta verdad: el Mar de Galilea y el Mar Muerto. El Mar de Galilea está lleno de vida: peces, vegetación y ecosistemas florecientes. El Mar Muerto, en cambio, hace honor a su nombre. Casi no contiene vida, más allá de algunas bacterias y hongos. ¿Por qué la diferencia?

R Ambos mares reciben agua del río Jordán. Pero solo uno deja salir el agua. El Mar de Galilea recibe y da. Porque da, sus aguas permanecen frescas y llenas de vida. El Mar Muerto solo recibe. Al no tener salida, el agua se estanca y se vuelve salada, incapaz de sostener la vida.

N Tú y yo somos como esos cuerpos de agua.

N Dios está constantemente dándonos: vida, talentos, oportunidades, relaciones y gracia. Nos da directamente, y también nos da a través de otras personas. Pero si solo recibimos y nunca damos de vuelta, algo empieza a suceder dentro de nosotros. Nuestro corazón se vuelve “salado”. La alegría se desvanece. La vida se marchita.

E Pero cuando damos, cuando devolvemos intencionalmente una parte de lo que hemos recibido, nuestra vida florece, a veces de las maneras más inesperadas.

E Por eso quiero invitarte a considerar devolverle a Dios, de manera intencional y agradecida, un porcentaje de tus ingresos. La Escritura habla del diezmo, el 10%, y muchas personas pueden dar testimonio de las profundas bendiciones que brotan de ese compromiso. Pero todos pueden comenzar en algún punto. La clave es la intencionalidad.

R Por ejemplo, si ganas \$50,000 al año, el 5 % sería \$2,500. O, si los porcentajes te parecen abrumadores, podrías ofrecerle a Dios las primeras dos horas de trabajo de cada semana como un acto de gratitud.

R Al hacer esto, no estamos “perdiendo” nada. Estamos devolviéndole a Dios una parte de lo que Él ya nos ha dado. Ese don puede apoyar a la parroquia, a una organización de caridad en particular o a la Diócesis de Dallas. Y una de las cosas hermosas es que podemos pedirle a Dios que nos guíe, que nos muestre dónde se necesita más nuestra ofrenda.

Sí, la parroquia necesita recursos para llevar a cabo su misión. Pero aún más profundamente, nosotros necesitamos dar. Es parte de cómo Dios nos creó. Es donde crece la libertad. Es donde la alegría cobra vida.

Así que durante estos últimos días de Cuaresma y al entrar en la alegría de la Pascua, te invito a unirme a mí para descubrir nuevas maneras de dar: con libertad, con intención y con alegría.

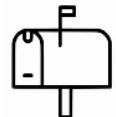
