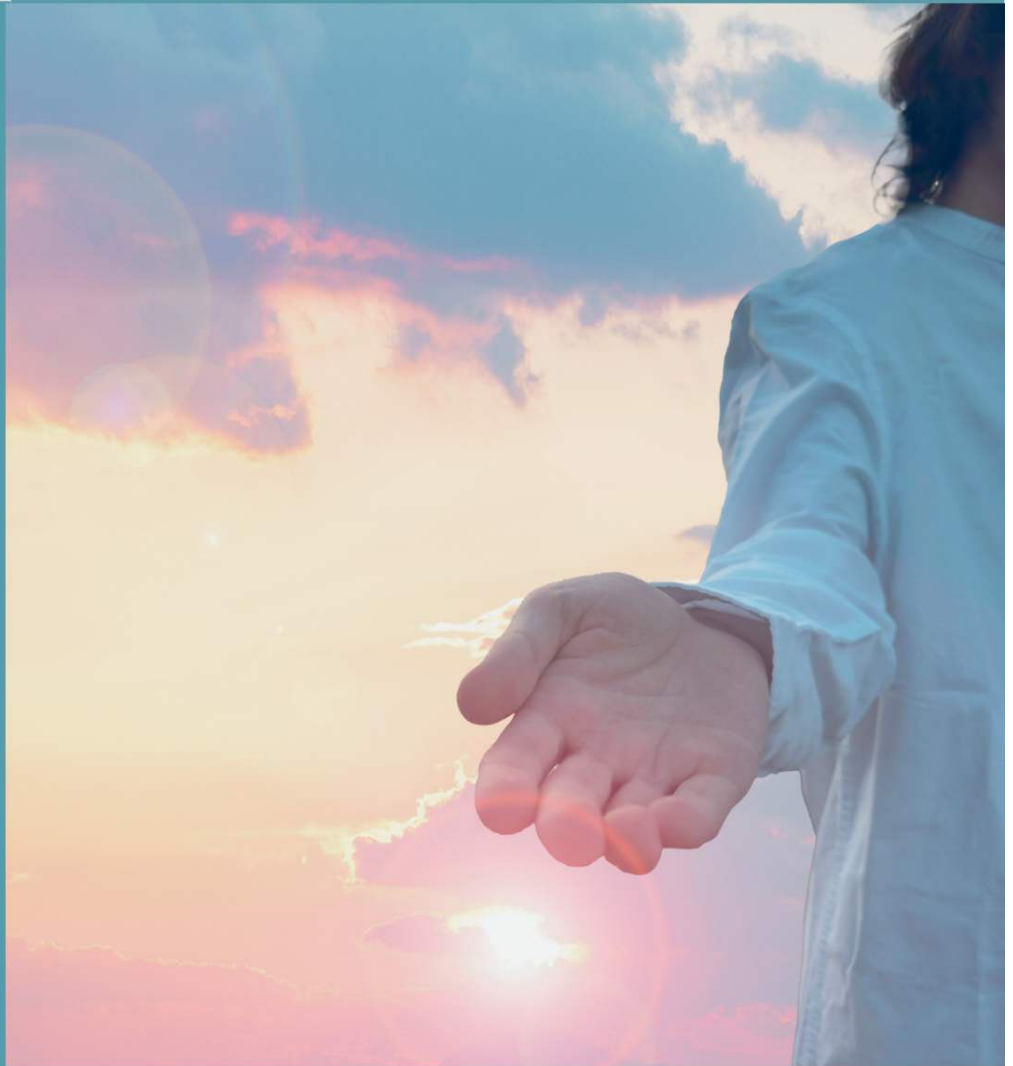

He created us, formed us, and entrusted each of us with unique gifts and talents. We are able to work, build relationships, raise families, and serve others flows because of these gifts and talents. This year we have several major projects planned, and our ongoing service to the community depends on your generosity.

Many of you are already living the beautiful call of Christian stewardship. You give generously in so many ways. I am deeply grateful for all the time, talent, and financial resources you loving give to St. Mark. Your gifts truly matter. They help people receive Christian formation, encounter Jesus in the holy sacraments, and come to know the saving grace of Jesus Christ through our Evangelization work.

Your generosity has real impact—and for that, I thank God for you.

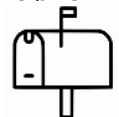

Mayordomía

Esta sola palabra expresa bellamente el corazón de nuestra vida cristiana. Dios ha dado tanto a cada uno de nosotros. Todo lo que tenemos y todo lo que somos es un regalo de Dios. 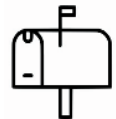
