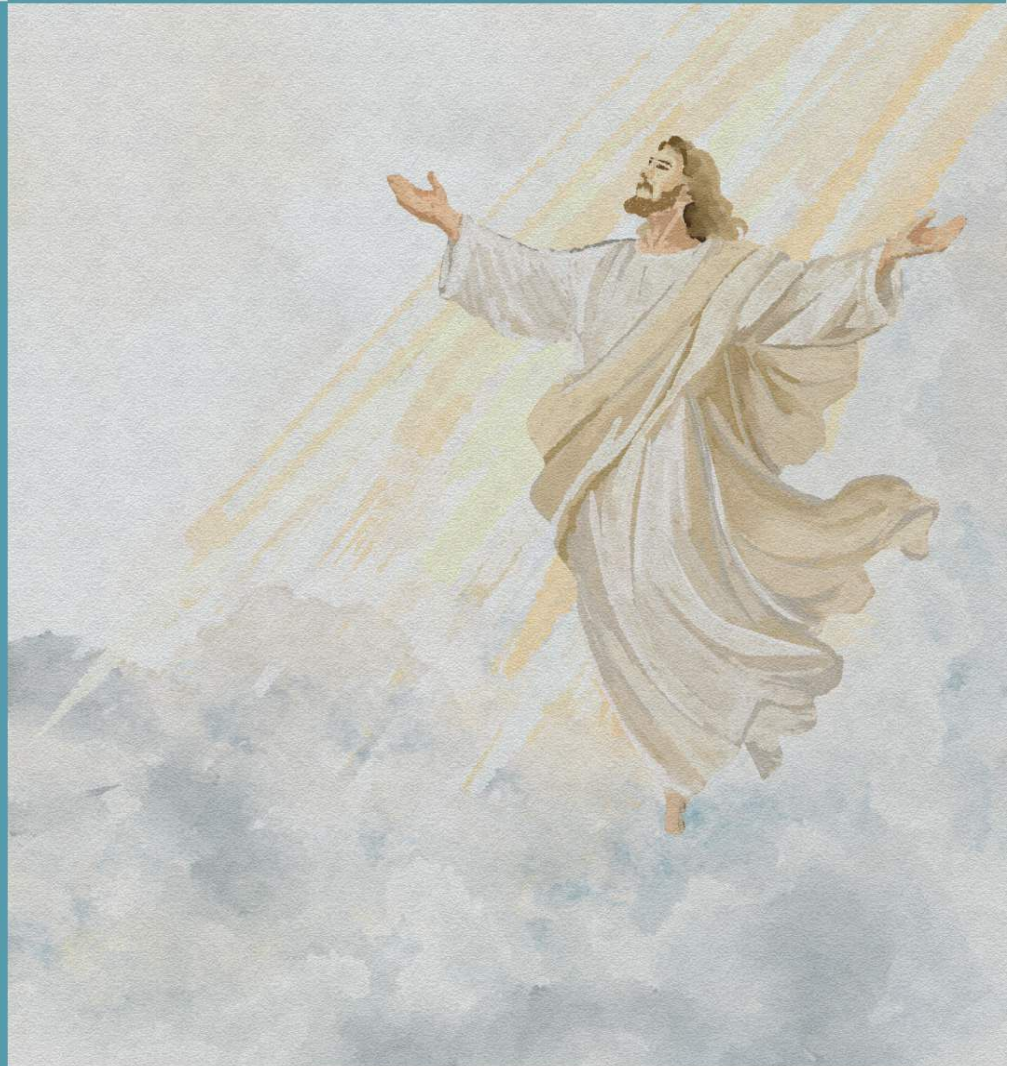

At St. Mark we are entering the beautiful season of First Holy Communion. Over the next several weeks, many of our children will come forward for the very first time to receive Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

R

Dressed in white dresses and handsome suits, they remind us of the purity, joy, and reverence that this sacrament deserves. These children have been preparing for this moment for two years. As a parish family, this is also an opportunity for all of us to reflect more deeply on the gift of the Holy Eucharist in our own lives.

N

- Holy Communion is meant to be received regularly and worthily. The Eucharist is spiritual food that strengthens us to live lives of holiness and goodness. If we are unable to receive Holy Communion because of serious sin or because of the state of our faith, it is still very important to come to Holy Mass and be present with the Lord. The best thing we can do is go to confession and begin working to change sinful habits. Think about this: when we choose not to come to Holy Mass every Sunday, we are saying that someone or something else is more important than Jesus.

E

- We should always treat the Holy Eucharist with the greatest reverence. Too often, we can begin to treat Holy Communion casually or like fast food. We do this when we regularly arrive late to Mass or leave early. We do this when we chew gum or ignore the Communion fast. We must remember that Holy Communion is not ordinary bread — it is receiving God Himself.

R

Once again, I am so proud of our First Communion families and of all our children receiving Jesus for the first time. It will be a joy to celebrate with them and to give them their second Holy Communion just one week later.

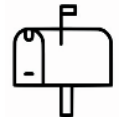

En St. Mark estamos entrando en la hermosa temporada de la Primera Comunión. Durante las próximas semanas, muchos de nuestros niños se acercarán por primera vez para recibir a Nuestro Señor en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

Vestidos con hermosos trajes y vestidos blancos, nos recuerdan la pureza, la alegría y la reverencia que este sacramento merece. Estos niños se han estado preparando para este momento durante dos años. Como familia parroquial, esta también es una oportunidad para que todos nosotros reflexionemos más profundamente sobre el don de la Sagrada Eucaristía en nuestras propias vidas.

- En cada Santa Misa, nos encontramos con el Dios vivo. En la Sagrada Comunión, Jesucristo entra verdaderamente en nuestro cuerpo y alma. ¡Qué misterio y regalo tan increíble!

E

- La Sagrada Comunión está destinada a recibirse con regularidad y dignamente. La Eucaristía es alimento espiritual que nos fortalece para vivir vidas de santidad y bondad. Si no podemos recibir la Sagrada Comunión debido a un pecado grave o por el estado de nuestra fe, sigue siendo muy importante venir a la Santa Misa y estar presentes con el Señor. Lo mejor que podemos hacer es ir a confesarnos y comenzar a trabajar para cambiar los hábitos pecaminosos. Piensen en esto: cuando elegimos no venir a la Santa Misa todos los domingos, estamos diciendo que alguien o algo es más importante que Jesús.

- Siempre debemos tratar la la Sagrada Eucaristía con la mayor reverencia. Muy a menudo, podemos comenzar a tratar la Sagrada Comunión de manera casual o como comida rápida. Hacemos esto cuando regularmente llegamos tarde a Misa o nos vamos temprano. Hacemos esto cuando mascamos chicle o ignoramos el ayuno antes de la Comunión. Debemos recordar que la Sagrada Comunión no es pan ordinario — es recibir a Dios mismo.

Una vez más, estoy muy orgulloso de nuestras familias de Primera Comunión y de todos nuestros niños que recibirán a Jesús por primera vez. Será una alegría celebrar con ellos y darles su segunda Sagrada Comunión apenas una semana después.

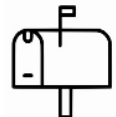


