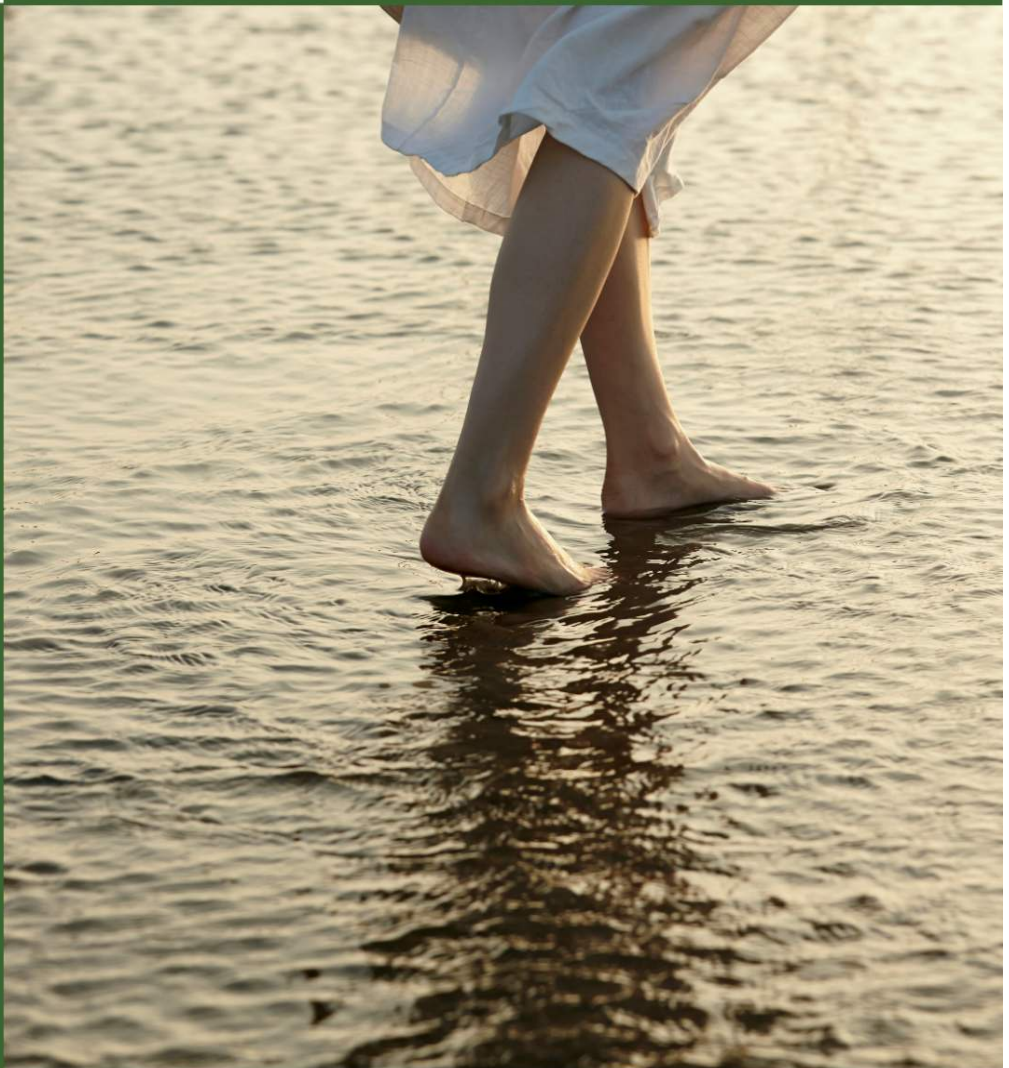

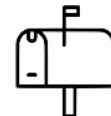

Beginning in August, the THIRD Sunday 10:30 & 12:30 Masses will be designated as a Low Sensory Mass to help our parishioners with sensory processing issues be able to fully participate in the Mass.

Begins August 16!

Lighting

For people with SPD, bright or artificial lighting can feel intense or even painful. These lights have an unbalanced spectrum compared to natural sunlight, which can cause visual stress. These light flicker or create glare, which can increase discomfort.

You will notice:

- Lights will be dimmed



Focus

Listening for shorter amounts of time limits the duration and volume of auditory input, making it easier to process what is being said. You will notice:

- Shorter Homilies
- Short form of long or complicated readings

Sounds

Quieter, gentler music and silence create a calming auditory environment.

You will notice:

- Calm music
- Fewer sudden loud sounds



Smells

People with SPD may experience over-responsiveness to odors, perceiving them as more intense than others do. This can lead to anxiety, discomfort, or even meltdowns, particularly when exposed to strong smells. You will notice

- Incense will not be used at all on these Sundays



Individuals with sensory processing differences may have difficulty receiving, interpreting, and responding to sensory information, making them more sensitive to lights, sounds, smells, and other environmental

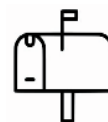
