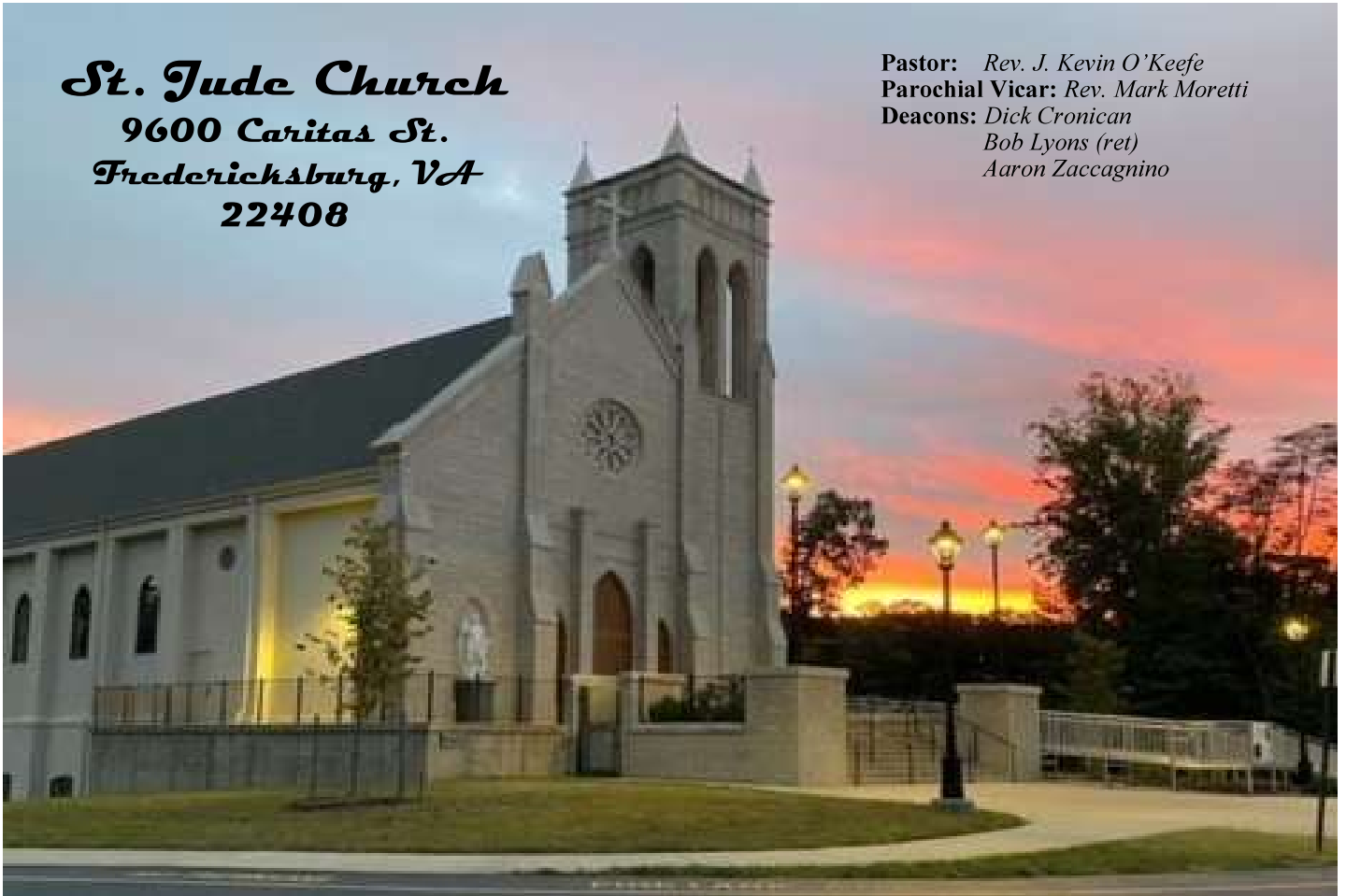

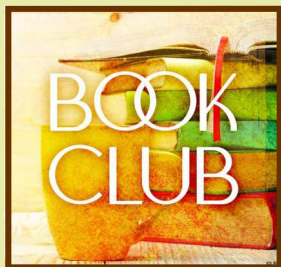

WHO ARE THE SECULAR FRANCISCANS?

Another of the many active ministries at Saint Jude is **The Order Secular Franciscan Order (OFS) Immaculata Fraternity**, a branch of the worldwide Franciscan Family. The OFS is a secular movement, established by St. Francis of Assisi more than 800 years ago. Our purpose is to bring the gospel to life where we live, work, and pray. We look for practical ways to embrace the gospel in our lives and try to help others to do likewise. We are single and married. We work, worship, and pray in the community where we live.

WHAT DO SECULAR FRANCISCAN DO?

Secular Franciscans follow the OFS rule that requires us to spend time in community with our Franciscan brothers and sisters. We gather at least monthly, the second Saturday of the month from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm. We support each other through the ups and downs of daily life. We pray together. We take opportunities to learn about and help our Church, our community, and our world.

Our rule mandates us to be involved in apostolic ministries and with youth. When we are called to action, we embrace the call rapidly and joyfully. Some of us are religious education teachers, some have a special ministry to animals, some have made a commitment to Perpetual Adoration. Some work with the poor and homeless. Some work in soup kitchens or visit the elderly and sick; some have youth ministries.

As a fraternity, we take action on issues that affect the lives of others. We do letter-writing campaigns in support of social justice issues; we support the efforts of our brothers and sisters who are serving the poor and lepers' half-way around the world.

IS THE OFS FOR YOU?

You will have plenty of time to get to know us before you make any commitment. The OFS requires three months of orientation and six months of inquiry. During that time, you will come to our monthly gatherings and have a few informal classes. Then, if you feel the call to continue, you will have another 18-36 months of formal discussion, education and involvement as a candidate. 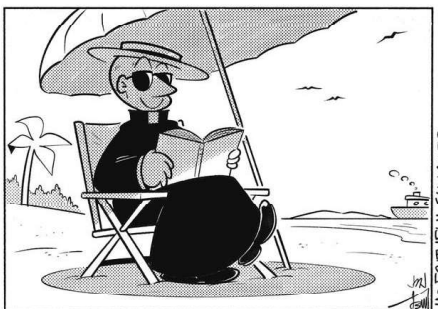


Mass for the Occasion of our Nation's 250th Anniversary of Independence

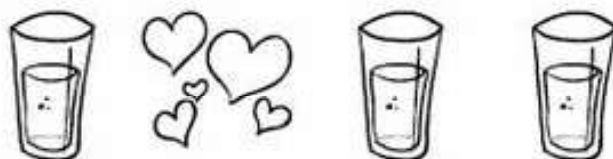
Sharing the Gospel

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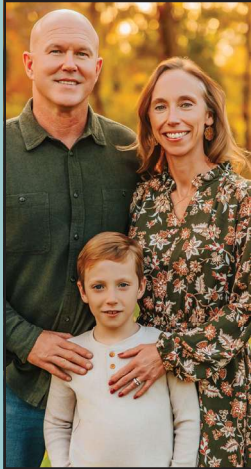

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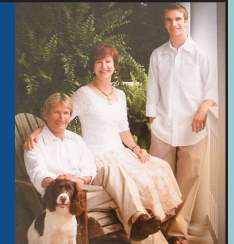
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
