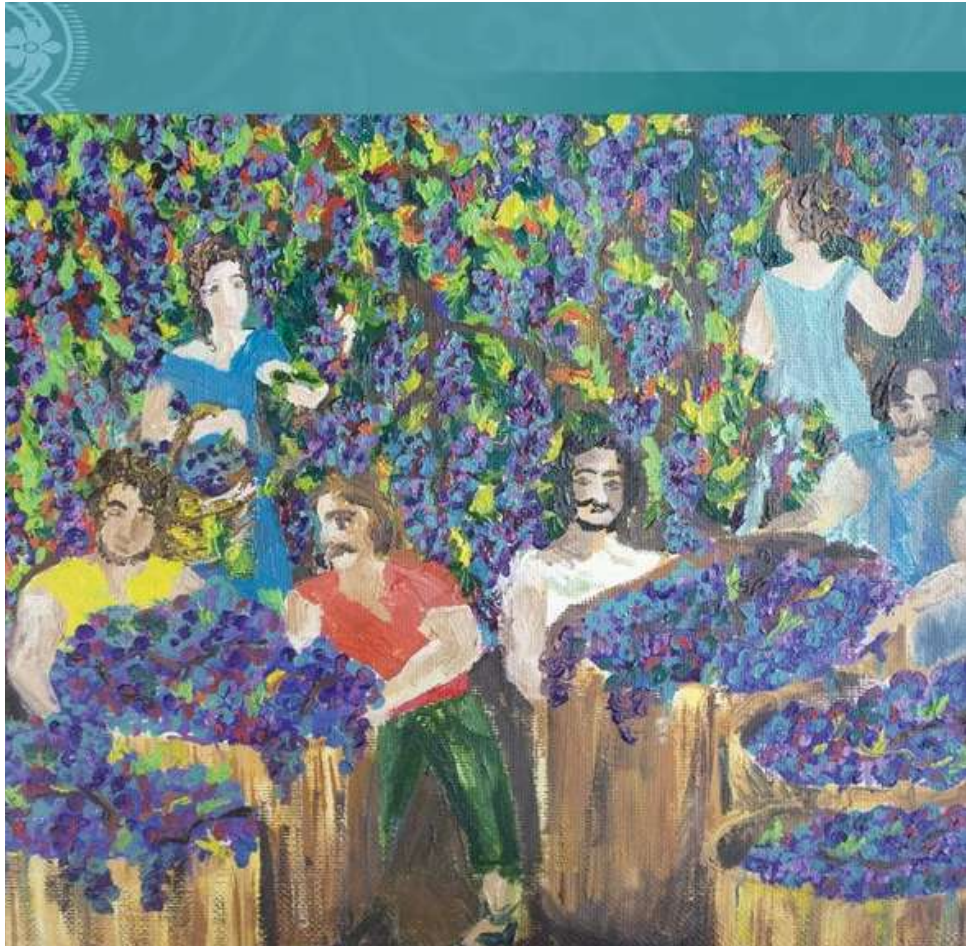

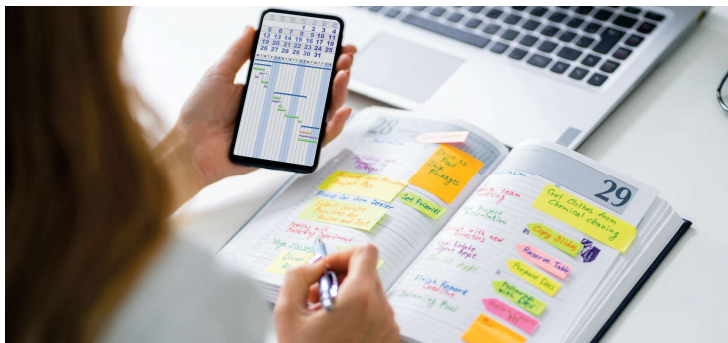

MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT

OCIA - ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Each Easter, more than a thousand adults of all ages formally become Catholic through parishes, missions, and campus ministry centers in the Catholic Diocese of Arlington. Some are baptized for the first time as adults, while others are Christians from other traditions entering into full communion with the Catholic Church. Their backgrounds and stories of faith are as diverse as the people who live in Northern Virginia. The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, or OCIA, is the process through which adults explore and, if they choose, eventually become Catholic, whether through Baptism or being received into full communion with the Church. Through OCIA you will have an opportunity to ask questions in a non-pressured environment alongside others who are on the same journey, learning the fundamental beliefs and practices of the Catholic faith and what it means to live as a Catholic.

OCIA Intake Night is September 29. The first night of class is October 13. If you are interested in OCIA, contact Nancy Simms at religiously@stjudechurch.us.

The course is free, and no preparation is required. Suggested readings are in the workbook, which you can purchase directly from Ascension Press.

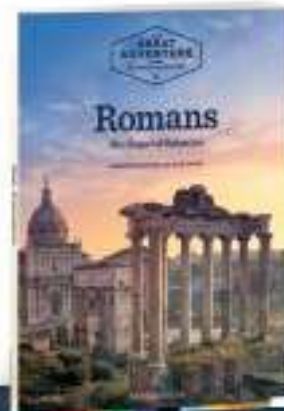
