

Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41 | Rev 5:11-14 | Jn 21:1-19 or 21:1-14

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

The accounts of Jesus' appearances to the disciples after his resurrection often puzzle me, and today's reading is no exception. There stands Jesus, within sight, yet the Apostles "did not realize that it was Jesus." Hello?! I know we're in the midst of a daylight saving time debate, but I'm fairly sure "dawn" meant the sun was up. Yet as soon as Jesus speaks and they follow his instructions, they realize he is their Lord. Simon Peter wastes no time; he dives into the sea and makes for the shore. Peter and the disciples show us that while it is important to recognize Jesus, it's what we do next that matters. As we learn in Acts, they boldly say his name despite the Sanhedrin's warning, and most will go on to be martyred for the Church. Thanks to them, we recognize Jesus - in the Eucharist, in Scripture, and in Tradition, and on the crucifixes in our homes and churches. Peter challenges us to "dive in," moving from faith to action. The specifics will differ for each of us, but we can study the lives of the Apostles and the saints to find inspiration.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Is it a Catholic thing or the fact that I'm a closet introvert? I sometimes struggle with talking about Jesus. Which is why today's reading from Acts challenges me. The Sanhedrin had warned the Apostles not to even speak Jesus' name. Yet they don't cower in fear or simply go back to the relatively quiet lives they led before they met Jesus. They rejoice to be found worthy "to suffer dishonor for the sake of [Jesus'] name." Their commitment challenges us to be bold - not only with our words but with our actions as well. In the same way that teaching another person math or spelling helps us learn, witnessing to our faith by sharing it with others helps us deepen our faith and answer God's call to be his disciple, striving to build his kingdom on earth.

STUDY This week, look up the feast days and read about the saint of the day. What can we learn from their example?

ime flies—I remember Fr. John Predmore coming to St. Mary's and talking about how he had read about the situation with the homeless at intersections of Mass and Cass (Massachusetts and Melnea Cass Avenues), and how he kept waking up with the prompting to do something tangible. So, he went to the website of the agency that is directly behind the infamous intersection and saw a unique opportunity at the Boston Healthcare for the Homeless Program (BCHCP), a fundraising project directly connected with the Boston Marathon.

It asked that participants raise \$10,000.00 for the agency, which would allow them a noncompetitive bid to enter the Boston Marathon. This is what he did—but going one better. Thanks to the generosity of our two parishes (St. Anthony's and St. Mary's), he raised over \$26,000! Congratulations, Fr. Predmore for not only helping those in need but running/walking the race and finishing it!

wo seminarians from Saint John Seminary in Brighton, MA have been assigned to St. Anthony of Padua Parish and Saint Mary of the Assumption Parish for their 8-week summer pastoral formation placement. For both Matthew and Aaron, this summer's 8-week pastoral placement is just a start to a longerterm pastoral formation experience in the parishes.

For Matthew this summer's 8-weeks with us is the start of a two-year placement, often called the "Deacon" assignment because it will, God-willing, lead to his ordination as a Deacon in June 2023 and his ordination as a priest in May 2024. After the summer experience, Matthew will return to the seminary for the 2022-2023 academic year, during which he will also have a few hours of pastoral formation in the parishes. He will be with us on the weekends for more pastoral formation, especially around preaching and celebration of





Sacraments appropriate to a Deacon.

For Aaron, this summer's 8-weeks with us is the start of a one-year full-time placement with for what is called a pastoral year. Having recently transferred from another diocese to the Archdiocese of Boston and from another seminary to Saint John Seminary, this pastoral year will allow Aaron to get to know the Archdiocese of Boston better and allow him to return to his seminary studies and his next pastoral assignment (his "Deacon" assignment) with this pastoral year as a new foundation. After this summer's 8weeks, Aaron will take a break and return to us full-time September 2022 through May 2023, with some appropriate breaks along the way!

We look forward to introducing you to, and welcoming, Matthew Harrington and Aaron Yohe, seminarians for the Archdiocese of Boston.


