


### Sharing the Word of God in Small Faith Groups

Many parishioners have been giving of their time to learn and teach God's word. Joining a small faith sharing group is a beautiful way to grow closer to God and your parish community.

We are so thankful for this fall's small group leaders Lillian Litchfield, Tina DelGuidice, Maureen Louzan, Diane Bourdeau & Rob Mortel, Barbara Lawlor, and Ed Rogers and for all those were leaders in the past.

Faith sharing groups follow the Lectio Divina format. Lectio Divina is a Latin phrase that means "divine reading" or "spiritual reading". It's a traditional Christian practice of reading, meditating, and praying on scripture to deepen one's relationship with God.

Parishioners have positive feedback regarding the faith sharing groups, one of which is the Bible study on the Gospel of Mark that meets on Thursdays after 9:00 am mass in St. Ann's Church. This group is Christ by the Sea's first Bible study group offered under the umbrella of small faith share groups. A member of the group says they "Love it!" and that they "Always wanted (to join) a Bible Study." The group utilizes Lectio Divina while reading the Gospel of Mark. The study supplements the group's learning with Dr. Tim Gray's videos and a study guide. Once they are done, they have a group discussion sharing what they just learned. "We learn how the New Testament fulfills the prophecies from the Old Testament."

Pope Francis has announced that 2025 will be a Jubilee Year, something which happens every 25 years. The theme for Jubilee 2025 is "Pilgrims of Hope," and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of COVID-19 pandemic, and the climate crisis. "Jubilee" is the name given to a particular year. A time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of Creation.
