### **Unexpected Capital Improvements**

It happens to all homeowners...the furnace doesn't work, the roof has a leak, the refrigerator suddenly stops working. These unexpected, unbudgeted items need to be taken care of, and typically can't wait. The same holds true for our three pieces of property. This quarter alone, the walk-in-refrigerator at the Parish Center stopped working. The roof at the rectory had a leak that unveiled chimney issues, and all furnaces needed to be serviced. The chimney at the rectory will need extensive masonry work (we MIGHT be able to hold off on this until spring/summer), the boiler at the rectory has a temporary fix and will cost upwards of \$30—\$40,000 to replace. Given the age of these items, insurance does not cover the cost to repair/replace. Of course we are gathering estimates, assessing the urgency of repair/replacement, exploring alternatives, etc.

We are already anticipating deficit spending for this fiscal year (our daily operating expenses will be more than our collections/ income). Adding unbudgeted capital improvements and general maintenance repairs on to that depletes are savings at a faster rate that anticipated. The Annual Report to the Parish been mailed. Please read Fr. Scott's and the Parish Finance Council letters for more details on our financial standing. Grand Annual letters will in the mail soon (if not already). We ask that you prayerfully consider your intentional giving to your parish. If you are not yet supporting your parish on a regular basis, and you are able to, please consider making a year end and continued contribution to your parish. If you are supporting your Parish and haven't increased your offering in a while, please pray about making an increase, if you are financially able to do so.







