Your gift matters

If you itemize your deductions

The Adjusted Gross Income limitation for charitable contributions in 2024 is 60%. You can deduct your cash contributions up to this percentage. Making a year-end gift may make you eligible to itemize your deductions.

Christmas office hours

Our office will remain open to receive any in-person donations until December 31st at noon. You can also send in your donation using the Grand Annual return envelope mailed to your home. You can even deposit your donation in the collection basket when you attend Mass.

You can donate online, right up to the last second of 2024!

You can make a gift from home! You can donate to St. Anthony's online at https://bit.ly/stanthonyegive In addition, any gift postmarked by December 31 can be applied to the 2024 calendar year.

Other cash-equivalent gifts are accepted!

Stocks, bonds, real estate, and more will be gratefully accepted and immediately used. You **may** be able to avoid capital gains taxes by making such gifts. You **may** also be able to avoid paying tax by making a distribution straight from your IRA account to St. Anthony of Padua Parish.
