NEW RESTROOM SIGNS

To further enhance our efforts to keep minors safe, each men's and women's room door at both parishes will have a wooden sign with 3 options to indicate if the bathroom is occupied.

Free

Adults Only

Children Only

Before going into the restroom the sign will need to be checked to ensure it is open for use. If the Restroom sign says **Free** it is ready for use. Before going into the restroom the sign will have to be moved to **Adults Only** or **Children Only** depending on the individual's age. If the sign to a bathroom with multiple stalls, such as in the main parish building, has **Adults Only** selected only adults can enter. If **Children Only** is selected only minors can enter.

If a minor needs adult assistance they may enter with their parent into an **Adult Only** bathroom. A minor going to the bathroom without assistance should always go into a **Children Only** bathroom.

YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING

WHY YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach adults how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis. The course introduces common mental health challenges for youth, reviews typical adolescent development, and teaches a 5-step action plan for how to help young people in both crisis and non-crisis situations. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including AD/HD), and eating disorders.

There is **NO** cost for this training.

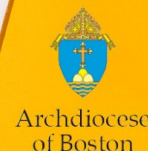
