St Vincent de Paul Annual Collection 2024



As you know, the Christ by the Sea Collaborative council of the St. Vincent DePaul Society provides critical financial assistance for clothing, food, medical expenses, housing, and utilities to our neighbors in need. Over this past year, direct financial assistance totaling nearly \$60,000 was provided. But in addition to material assistance, we also provide emotional and spiritual support to those who feel they have nowhere else to turn. This year we have continued our practice of offering those we help a boxed crucifix with Jesus' comforting words from St. Matthew's Gospel: "Come to me all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

For a number of years, our endeavors have been funded by the generous donations of our parish community and supported by the various programs sponsored by the St. Vincent de Paul Society of Massachusetts such as the heating assistance program and security deposit program.

Each year there is a special collection to support this important work, and this will be held at all of the Masses in both parishes on the weekend of September 28 and 29. With the soaring costs of nearly all of life's necessities, requests for assistance this past year increased, and we fully expect this trend to continue, especially during the upcoming Winter. So your support of this collection will be greatly appreciated. 
