Offertory Counting and Data Entry in our Parishes

While both our parishes are blessed to have monetary donations at each weekend mass, we often have a lack of donated time to count it! When the church is working with money it takes at least 3 volunteers per group to get the job done efficiently. Recently we have been struggling to gain enough volunteers to effectively deposit our offertory through rotating teams of offertory counters. We need more volunteers like you to help.

Offertory Counting happens once a week on Sunday or Monday and takes 1-2 hours. If we are able to organize 4 teams of at least 3 parishioners, you would only need to count once a month!

Our parishes also struggle to get volunteers to enter these donations into our database. This is needed to report back to you each year for tax purposes.

Data entry occurs once a week for roughly an hour. You can work from home or in the office. You can work alone or grab a partner!

Below is a testimony of one of our data entry volunteers:

I started volunteering at St. Mary's office before Covid changed our lives. I do data entry and prior to beginning this journey, I had just the basic knowledge of using a computer. Denise taught me all I needed to know and honestly, it takes maybe an hour a week. You can work from home or at the office, it's up to you. It takes many hands to have things run smoothly in a Parish. Your gift of time would be truly appreciated.

All you need to get started is your own laptop (or computer or Mac, etc.) and you are ready to go. If you don't have a laptop, you can work in the office and use one of the volunteer laptops. Training will be provided and if you have a friend who is interested, teams are encouraged.

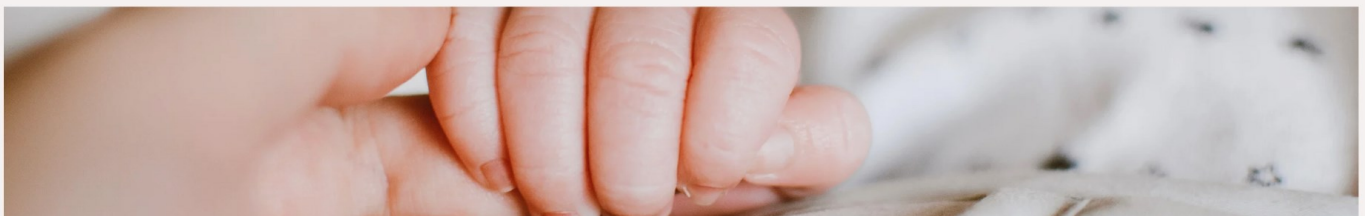

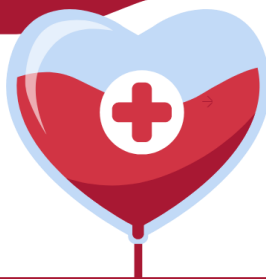
"The Visitation and Life before Birth. Why Catholics are Called to be Pro-life."

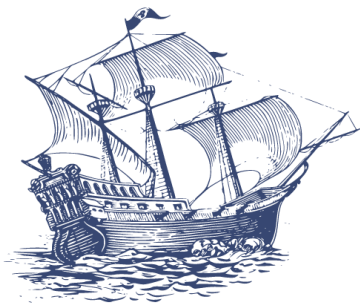
