

VOTER PETITION TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

After Masses in each of our churches on October 11-2 and 18-19, parishioners will be inviting fellow parishioners to give prayerful consideration to signing a voter petition to amend the Massachusetts State Constitution. Specifically, the amendment would "Permit the state to exclude abortion services from statefunded health care." In 2024, Massachusetts paid \$6,444,419 for abortion services. This proposed change, if adopted, could help save the lives of many unborn children. Parishioners will be outside the church with petition sheets after all Masses in both of our churches on October 11-12 and 18-19.




