During the 50 days of Easter, we celebrate Jesus Christ's Resurrection and Ascension. The Easter season concludes with the Pentecost celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit. This year, the Easter season goes from the 8:15 p.m. Easter Vigil on April 19 through the 5:00 p.m. Mass on June 8.

Celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation - Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist - is a key characteristic of the Easter season. Our recent practice has been to celebrate these Sacraments during regularly scheduled parish Masses. We often celebrate Baptism at 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass at St. Ann Church and occasionally at Sunday Masses at St. Anthony Church. In recent years, we have celebrated Confirmation and First Communion at Sunday Masses in both churches. Why?

The scheduling of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion during regular Sunday Eucharist times emphasizes the centrality of the regular Sunday worship cycle. Family-centered celebrations at a Sunday liturgy emphasize that it is in the family that children find nourishment in Christian life. Celebrating these Sacraments at Sunday liturgy witness to the communal nature of the Eucharist.

This Easter season will be filled with many things, most importantly, these Sacramental celebrations.

At the Easter Vigil, 3 adults (2 in Cohasset and 1 in Hull) will receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion.

Baptisms will be celebrated throughout the Easter season.

Confirmation will be celebrated at 10:00 a.m. Mass on May 11 at St. Ann Church, and 5:00 p.m. on May 18, at St. Anthony Church.

First Communion will be celebrated at 4:00 p.m. Mass on May 3 at St. Ann Church. We will celebrate First Communion at St. Anthony Church on May 3 at 5:30 p.m. Mass, May 4 at 8:30 and 11:30 a.m. Masses, May 10 at 5:30 p.m. Mass, and May 11 at 11:30 a.m. Mass.

At a Pentecost Mass, 3 children (2 in Cohasset and 1 in Hull) will be Baptized and Confirmed, and receive First Communion. At another Pentecost Mass, 4 children, already baptized and beyond the age of reason, will be Confirmed and receive First Communion.

This is an exciting time for all celebrating or receiving Sacraments in the Easter season, their families and friends, our parishes, and the Church!





EASTER MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP HENNING
