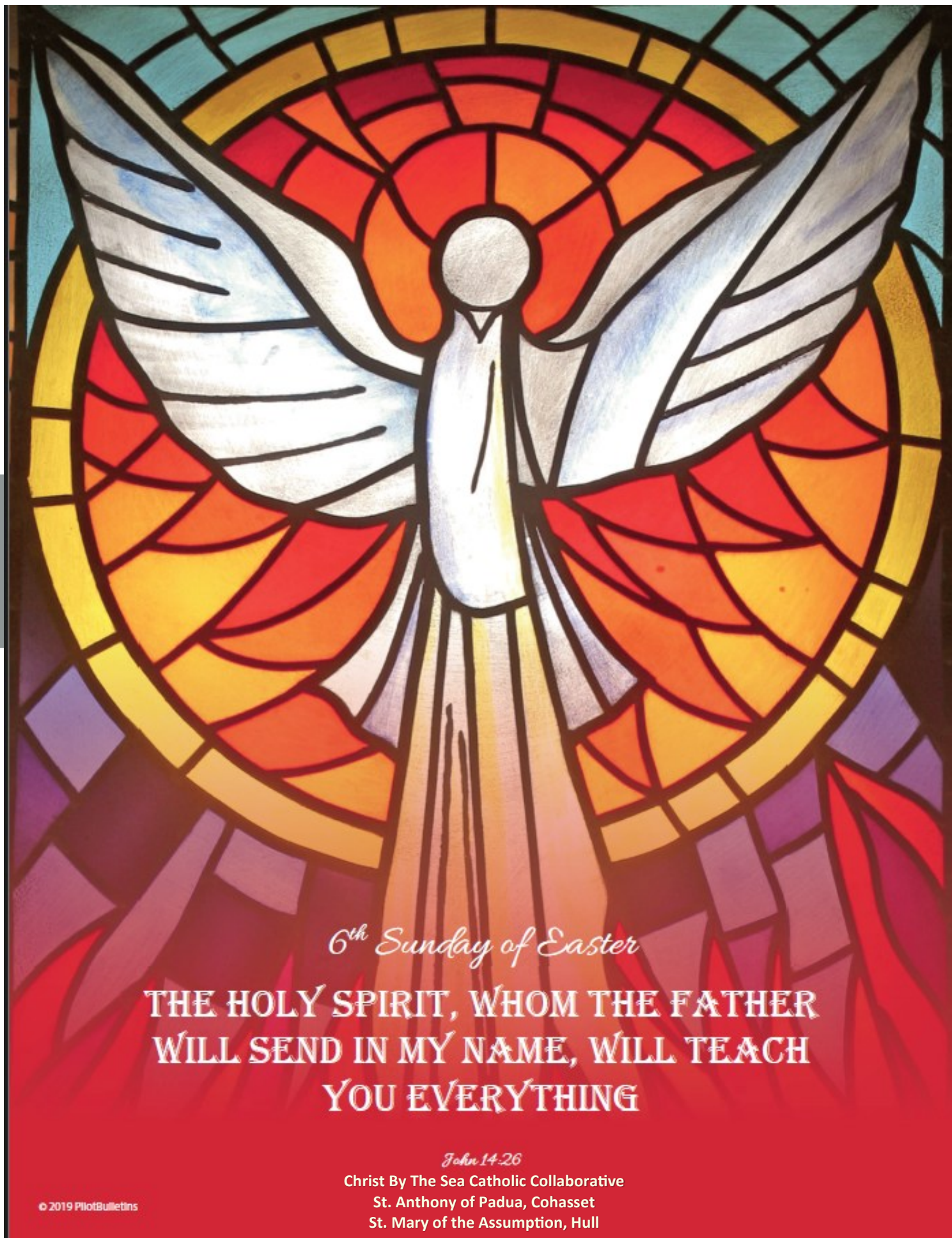

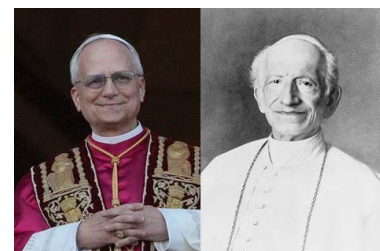


Leo XIII - Leo XIV: Will Learning about XIII Introduce us to XIV?

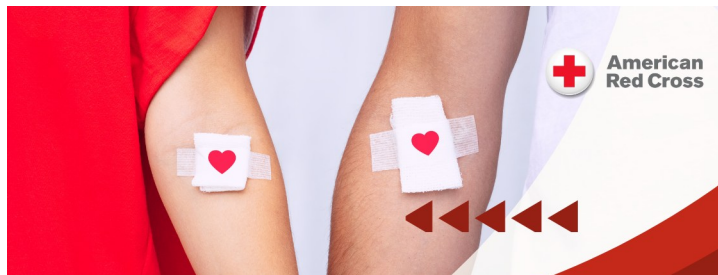

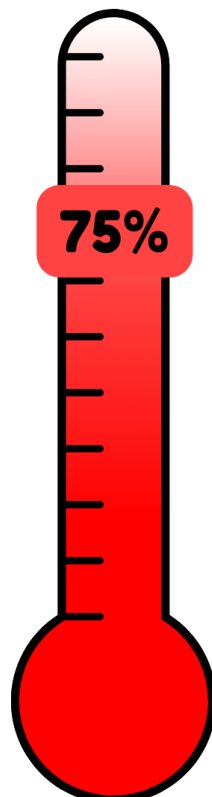
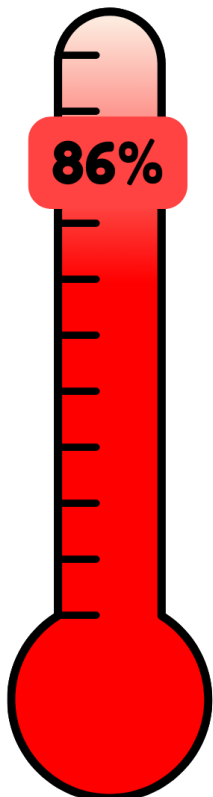
