ADVOCATE FOR CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES SCHOOL FEEDING PROGRAMS

Catholic Relief Services received formal notification that the administration has terminated all but two of Catholic Relief Services' McGovern-Dole Food for Education school feeding programs, cutting off daily meals for nearly 800,000 children in 11 countries beginning in July. For many, this was their only meal of the day.

recreational games.

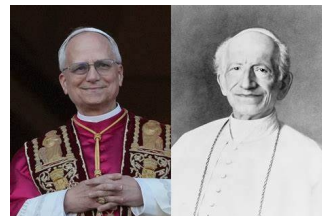

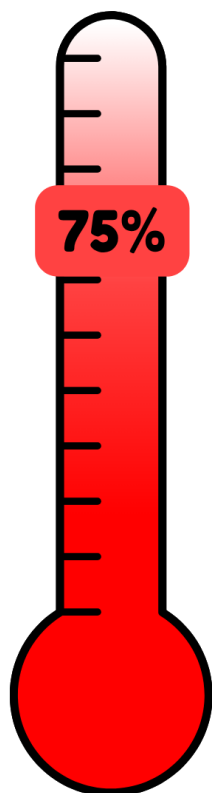
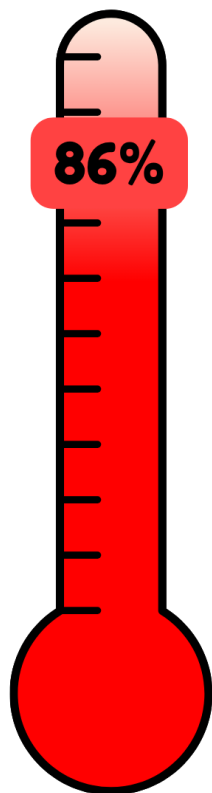
