St. Vincent de Paul Update

In this past weekend's Gospel, Jesus told the parable of the Good Samaritan. He instructed us to Love God and to love our neighbor as ourselves. The mission to love and serve our neighbors in need is at the very heart of the Society of St. Vincent DePaul. For many years we have been blessed to be able to help hundreds of our neighbors who are struggling with a variety of issues which are compounded by the economic conditions they — and we - face every day. Our interventions have helped them to stabilize their lives to some degree, but have also reassured them that someone really does care. But this success has come with a price, and the amount of money available to help those in need of assistance has dwindled substantially. The recent volume of requests for help with basics like rent, utility and food has reduced our available funds from around \$16,500 in January to our current balance which will be around \$1,500 after our most recent situations are addressed. Our annual fundraiser is scheduled for the fall, but there is a very real danger that our funds will be depleted well before that. If


