Jim Flanagan, who has served as our Coordinator of Youth Ministry and Faith Formation for grades six and higher since September 2022, has accepted a new position as Director of Faith Formation for Saint Mary Parish in Franklin. We are still working to determine his last day in our parishes.

We give thanks to God for his three-year ministry here and ask God to bless him in this new position. We also thank Jim for the past three years of youth ministry, preparing young people for the Sacrament of Confirmation, leading faith formation for grades six through eight, supporting the implementation of family faith formation, and starting the process of moving the Sacrament of Confirmation from grade ten to grade eight.

Fr. Scott and Fr. Hung have started to consult with staff, key volunteers who have worked with Jim, and our members in grades six through twelve and their families, to make plans to provide faith formation (formerly called CCD or religious education) for grades six and seven, preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation for grades eight and nine, and a comprehensive youth ministry for grades six and higher. Rest assured, that our goal in ministering to our young people and their families is to draw them closer to Christ and His Church.
