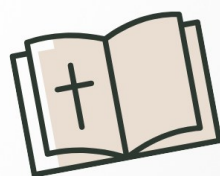

The WONDER pathway is for families who have already participated in ROOT and do not have a child preparing for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.

WONDER includes Church Sessions and 10 At-Home Meetings during which family members will encounter the power of storytelling in the parables of Jesus through engaging their imaginations, hands-on activities, and meaningful conversations. Families will draw out the moral of each story and apply it to their daily lives. The transforming stories of our faith will come alive in the homes of families, with WONDER.
