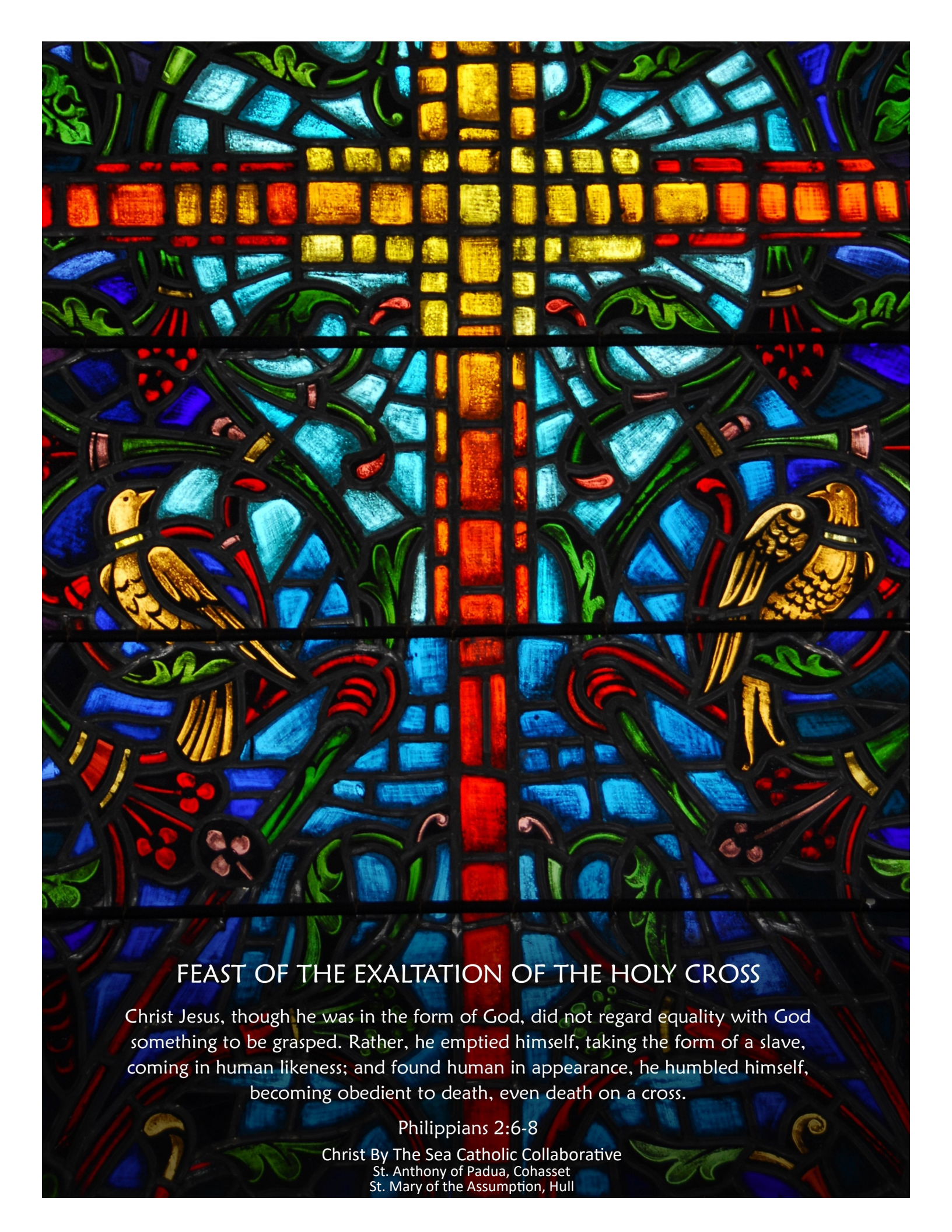




## FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

## ***AN INCREASED OFFERTORY PROGRAM FOR OUR PARISH***

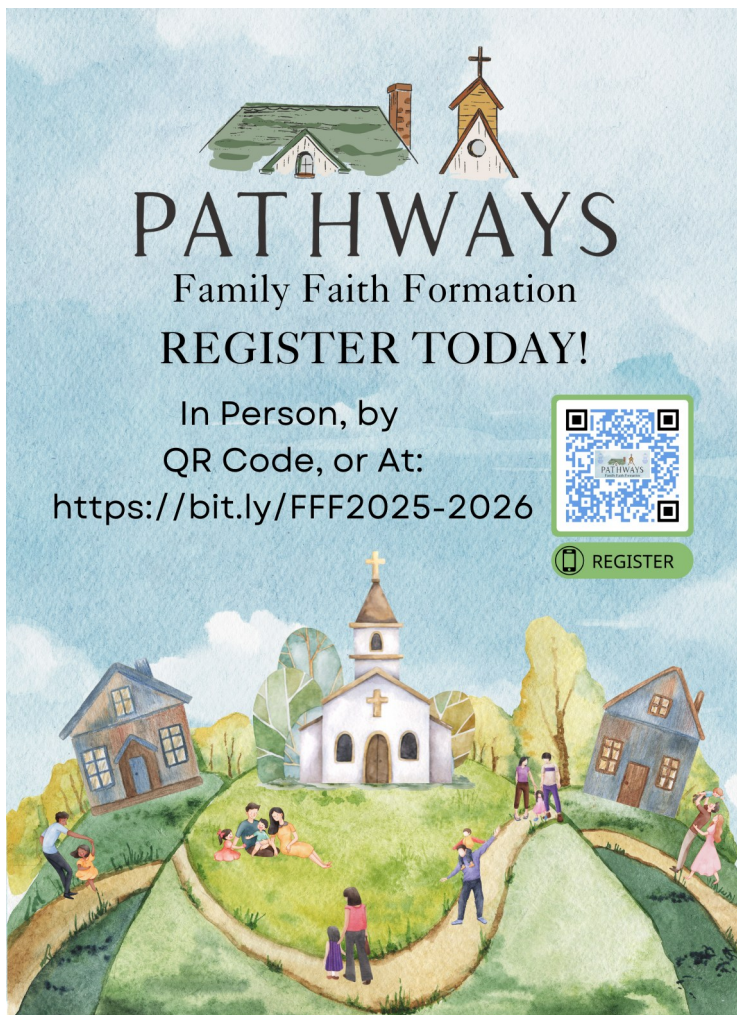

and receive a special blessing.

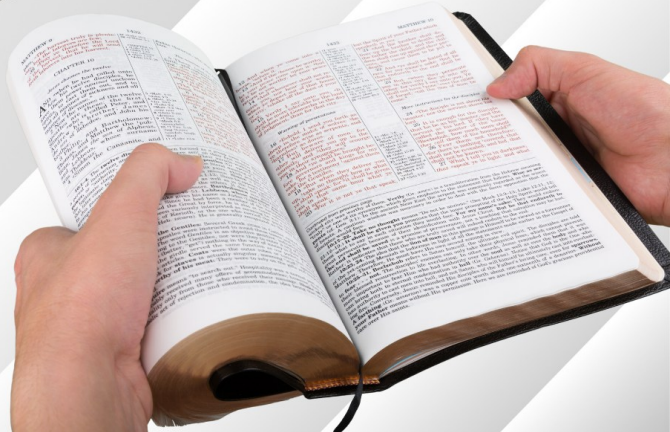

## BOX OF JOY



Beginning October 4th, Christ by the Sea Collaborative will be teaming up for the third year with Cross Catholic Outreach in their "Box of Joy" Ministry. For those who may not have had the opportunity to participate in previous years, this is a simple but meaningful way for us to provide Christmas gifts for desperately poor children in Haiti, Guatemala and other developing countries. It's also very easy, family-friendly and inexpensive. We're asked to fill as many standard size shoe boxes (provided by Cross Catholic Outreach) as possible with small gifts that will then be delivered by them to children in need in time for Christmas. Last year we filled 221 boxes! The boxes, an information brochure, a suggested gift list and a sign-up list will be available for pickup beginning on October 4th in the Gathering Space at St. Mary's and the main foyer at St. Anthony's. They will also be available for Faith Formation families beginning this week. Boxes will be returned by the weekend of November 1-2 for shipping. Imagine the squeal of joy and excitement when a child receives a whole box of small gifts!
