Greetings to all the faithful of St. Ignatius of Loyola Parish! It was so great to begin to meet you last weekend and begin to serve this vibrant and diverse parish. I began to introduce myself to you last week as well as my religious community the **Congregation of Saint John**, a religious order founded in France, and composed of three Catholic congregations: the Brothers of Saint John, the Apostolic Sisters of Saint John, and the Contemplative Sisters of Saint John. The

I am very excited to join you in this new adventure of faith, and I look forward to getting to know you and serving you as your pastor. I also hope that you will join me in praying for our country, that it may always uphold the dignity and rights of every human person, especially the most vulnerable, and that it may always promote peace and harmony among all peoples.

On a personal note, I would like to share with you a special joy that my family celebrated this week: my grandfather, who is a retired **deacon** in Austin Texas, turned **95** on July 5th. He is a great example of faithfulness and service for me, and I am very grateful for his life and his ministry. He is also very proud of me being a priest, and he always encourages me to be faithful to my vocation. Please keep him in your prayers, as I keep you in mine.

May God bless you all and may St. Ignatius of Loyola intercede for us!
