Notes from Fr. Francis

Dear Parishioners of St. Ignatius Parish,

This Sunday, we celebrate the glorious feast of the Transfiguration. As Jesus' divinity shone brightly, illuminating Peter, James and John, so too may we behold Christ's majesty and find our faith renewed.

The Transfiguration echoes Jesus' parables about hidden treasures being revealed. What glimpses of glory do we perceive amid ordinary life? Gregory the Great wrote that the kingdom is “heavenly delight” found through spiritual discipline. Like seeds growing secretly, our eyes gradually adjust to divine radiance.

At the Transfiguration, the disciples yearned to remain with Jesus, Moses and Elijah on the mountaintop. Yet their life's work awaited below. We too feel torn between earthly duties and spiritual heights. As Hilary of Poitiers wrote: “Eternal riches are not possessed without worldly loss.”

Moses beheld God's glory on Mount Sinai, and his face was veiled when he descended. In the same way, we can return to our daily lives after experiencing God's glory, bearing with us the light that we have seen. When we are discouraged, we can remember the brilliant cloud that overshadowed our fear with joy. This cloud is a reminder that God is with us even in our darkest moments, and that He will never leave us or forsake us.

Friends, keep seeking glimpses of holy mystery amid ordinary days. Nurture mustard seed faith; treasure time with the Word. For at unexpected moments, we too may be transfigured, beholding “the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.”

May the light of Christ transfigure our hearts and lives, filling us with hope, love, and joy. May it guide us through the darkness and help us to see the beauty in all things. May it strengthen us in our faith and help us to live a life of peace and compassion.

Help us help our neighbors by bringing any of these non-perishable grocery items to the pantry/garage at the corner of 23rd and Gaylord: Paper towels, toilet paper, reusable grocery bags, cooking oils, mayonnaise, Miracle Whip, mustard, ketchup, pancake syrup/mix, canned fruits and vegetables (no green beans), canned tomatoes, tomato sauce and paste, canned tuna, chicken and salmon, hearty soups, canned chili, sloppy joe mix, canned stews, pasta sauce, SpaghettiOs, peanut butter, jelly, coffee, sugar, flour, masa, pasta, crackers, rice (white only), taco seasoning and shells, tortillas, Hamburger/Tuna Helper, salsa, hot sauce, honey, and cereal/oatmeal.
