"Capital improvements includes payments made in 23-24 toward the Parish Center Roof Replacement and the sidewalks from the Parish Center toward the Church, also includes the driveway at the rectory. In 2024-2025 \$55,000 was requested from the Inspired by the Spirit Campaign funds to reimburse the parish for these expenses.
