Mark your calendars for the annual Ministerial Alliance Thanksgiving Service, in which we gather as a community to give thanks to God for the past year and ask Him to bless us and those whom we meet. There will be a service in the church with a free will offering, followed by a light reception.

In review from the last ten months, through October 24th, the alliance helped out 74 different requests for a total of \$13,816.21: \$6758.42 in electric bills, \$4635 in rent, \$1314.50 in utility bills, \$861.26 in propane, \$52.73 in groceries, \$40 in bus fare, 124.30 in hotel stays, and \$30 in gasoline.
