

FINANCIAL UPDATE:

Because of in-person Mass cancellations and financial uncertainty resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, weekly collections at Church of the Holy Family have been rather unpredictable. To be able to continue paying our staff and keep the church running, we applied for and were granted a short term federal Payroll Protection Program (PPP) loan, which provides monies to help pay staff wages and other operating expenses (such as utilities) for a maximum of eight weeks. We are carefully monitoring how we spend this, keeping in mind the restrictions attached to it. We are thankful for this short-term assistance, but even with this money, we are below budget and trust that, with your grateful stewardship, we will be back to normal financial conditions soon.


