IGNATIAN FAMILY TEACH-IN FOR JUSTICE Oct 22-24, 2022 | Washington, D.C.

Learn, pray, and advocate for justice at the largest annual Catholic social justice gathering in the United States.

The Teach-In is a place for members of the Ignatian family (Jesuit institutions and larger church) to be empowered, reenergized, inspired, challenged and supported by a community that sees faith and justice integrally linked. Now in its 25<sup>th</sup> year, the teach-in has a rich history rooted in honoring the Jesuits and their companions who were martyred in El Salvador

According to Lauren (One of the three Holy Family teenagers to go to the Ignatian Family Teach-in last year) "During the course of the weekend, the keynote speakers became my inspiration and their speeches united a bridge of Christ and Justice. Keya Chatterjee was especially my favorite, as she spoke on the growing threat of climate change and how the church and Christ have enough faith to unite and promote efficient ways to help the climate and slow global warming. All the attendees were energetic and enthusiastic."

#### **Afghan Resettlement Update**

In December 2021, Holy Family assisted Commonwealth Catholic Charities in the resettlement of six Afghan men. Since then, all the men have received their work authorization and social security cards. They all work, with two men working more than one job. One is training with One Hour Heating and Air Conditioning. Three of the men are continuing in summer school at the adult learning center. They are now responsible for all their bills. They are in the process of completing the application for asylum through the College of William and Mary. They miss their families and country immensely and are extremely thankful for all the support from Holy Family.

#### **Deadly Earthquake near Khost Afghanistan**

On June 22, 2022, a 5.9 magnitude earthquake struck the Central Region of Afghanistan in the Paktika and Khost provinces, killing over 1,000 people and injuring 1,500. One of our sponsored men, is from the Khost province. He was able to contact his family and thankfully everyone is well. Please pray for the families of the victims and for those who are injured.

#### "CREATION CARE CORNER":

Global warming from fossil fuels continues to increase! The last time carbon dioxide levels on our planet were as high as today was more than 4 million years ago. Increased emissions of greenhouse gas have led to a rapid and steady increase in global temperatures, which in turn is causing catastrophic events all over the world.

Australia and the U.S. are experiencing some of the most devastating **bushfire seasons** ever recorded. **Locusts are swarming** across parts of Africa, the Middle East, and Asia decimating crops. A **heat wave** occurred in Antarctica that saw temperatures rise above 20 degrees for the first time. **Deforestation** in the Amazon rain forest is increasing.

Representing arguably the biggest of the environmental problems is melting ice caps and sea level rise. Making this problem an even greater concern was the loss last summer of 60 billion tons of ice from Greenland, enough to raise global sea levels by 2.2mm in just 2 months. The climate crisis is warming the Arctic more than twice as fast as anywhere else on the planet. Today, sea levels are rising more than twice as quickly as they did for most of the 20th century resulting from increasing temperatures on Earth. The sea level rise will have a devastating impact on all, but especially those living in coastal regions. According to the research and advocacy group, Climate Central, sea level rise this century could flood coastal areas that are now home to 340 to 480 million people, forcing them to migrate.

Even if all greenhouse gas emissions were immediately halted, global temperatures would continue to rise in the coming years. That is why it is absolutely IMPERATIVE that we start now (today!), to drastically REDUCE these emissions, INVEST in renewable energy sources and PHASE OUT our fossil fuels as fast as possible.

Another one of the biggest 2022 environmental problems is <u>food waste</u>. This leads to food insecurity. Food waste and loss account for a third of greenhouse gas emissions annually. In developed countries, 40% of food waste and loss occurs at the retail and consumer levels. At the retail level, a shocking amount of food is wasted because of aesthetic reasons. In our country, more than 50% of all produce thrown away is done so because it is deemed "too ugly" to be sold, which amounts to 60 million tons of fruits and vegetables.

While these are a few of the biggest 2022 environmental problems plaguing our planet, there are many more that remain to be mentioned. In our day to day lives, we need to become more conscious of our own activities that contribute to these problems. A response to the crisis must be practical and far-reaching enough to make a difference.


