**ROSARY:**

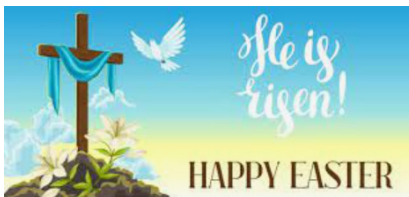

Grief is the conflicting feelings caused by a change or an end in a familiar pattern or behavior; it is the normal and natural reaction to loss. Our Bereavement Support Group meets Tuesdays at 2:00 p.m. in the Parish Library. If you or someone you know is grieving, please join us. These meetings will be confidential and held in a safe environment.

“CREATION CARE CORNER:”

The UN Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change just issued its latest report indicating that the Earth is swiftly approaching perilous overheating. The report states that nations will need to make an immediate and drastic shift away from fossil fuels to prevent the planet from overheating dangerously beyond that level. The panel offers the most comprehensive understanding to date of ways in which the planet is changing. It states that global average temperatures are estimated to rise 1.5 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels sometime around “the first half of the 2030s” as humans continue to burn coal, oil, and gas.

In a film he produced, David Attenborough maintains that all hope is not yet lost. Feasible solutions include:

1. Stabilize The Global Population: To slow the population growth rate, we need to raise people out of poverty, improve access to healthcare globally and enable children, especially girls, to stay in school for as long as possible.

2. Shift To Renewable Energy: Globally, renewable energy may be the dominant source of energy in 20 years. Mr. Attenborough calls for divestment from fossil fuels, and points out the irony of banks and investment firms investing pension funds in fossil fuels, which are the very culprits that are preventing the future we are saving for.

3. Restore Biodiversity: When ecosystems are more diverse, they are better able to perform essential ecosystems services, like carbon sequestration. He asserts that globally, if no-fish zones were implemented over a third of the world’s oceans, we would have all the fish we would need. The UN is trying to do just that. We also need to reduce the space we use for farmland to instead make space for returning wilderness. This would mean we would have to change our diets. He maintains that if we all had a largely plant-based diet, we would need just half the land we use now.

4. End Deforestation: Finally, deforestation needs to be halted. Forests are the planet’s biggest ally in locking away carbon. Further, forests must be more biodiverse as this will make them more effective at absorbing carbon. Crops like oil palm and soya should only be grown on land that was deforested long ago. A century ago, more than three-quarters of Costa Rica was covered by forests. By the 1980s, it was reduced to one-quarter due to deforestation. The government intervened giving grants to landowners to replant trees. Now forests cover half of Costa Rica. The problem of deforestation is immense, but we already have the knowledge and skills to halt and reverse it. We need to work with nature instead of against it, to restore our planet to its former glory. We need to get moving with greater action!

- Those adults who have been baptized in a recognized non-Catholic Christian tradition
- Those adults who were baptized Catholic, but have not celebrated Eucharist and Communion

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you **have** to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.

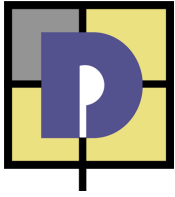

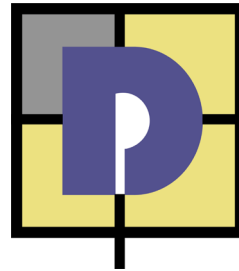
