“CREATION CARE CORNER”

EARTH DAY has become a common household phrase. Most everyone nowadays is familiar with this annual celebration and participates in activities that honor and safeguard our Earth. People pretty much know that this event was first held in 1970 in New York City, initiated by a

senator. With each passing year since then, Earth Day has become more and more popular.

It has also become common knowledge now that our Earth is in critical danger of becoming uninhabitable with the threat of climate change, mostly triggered and promoted by the prevailing use of fossil fuels. Earth Day has become not only a means of educating people about Earth's many benefits, our essential dependence on Her for survival, but also to develop gratitude for Her as well as live in a way that fosters Her well-being.

We parishioners of the Holy Family Church will be setting aside the weekend of April 22/23 to pay tribute to and give thanks for our Earth and Her many gifts through the liturgies we celebrate. We will sing hymns in praise of Her and pray petitions in the Prayer of the Faithful for the Earth's well-being and that She thrive, so that Her creatures, including humans, will enjoy a flourishing environment.

Members of the Sowers of Justice will have a couple of tables between liturgies displaying alternatives available in place of plastic items. For instance, reusable canvas bags instead of plastic bags; bamboo straws instead of plastic straws; cloth bags for storing greens instead of plastic that the stores supply; bars of soap instead of liquid soap to avoid the plastic container. Spend a few minutes to acquaint yourself with ways you can eliminate single use plastic in your lives.

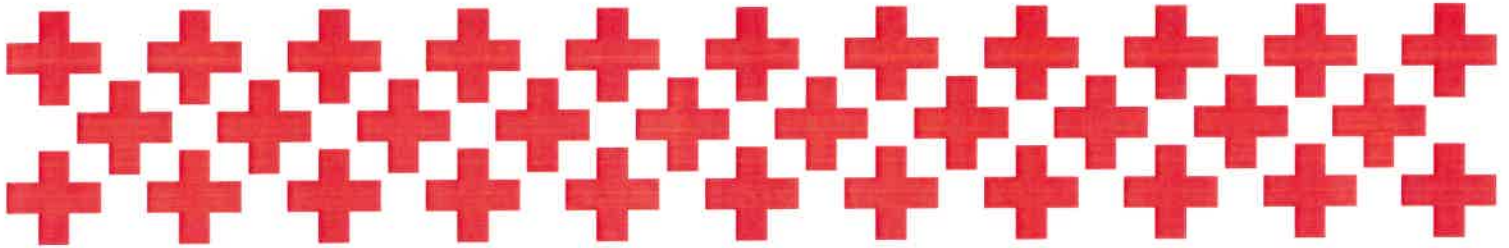

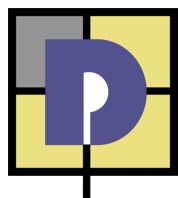

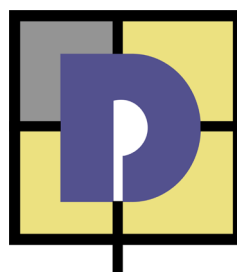
