- Those adults who have been baptized in a recognized non-Catholic Christian tradition
- Those adults who were baptized Catholic but have not celebrated Eucharist and Communion

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you **have** to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.

CREATION CARE

"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

Single-use plastics are everywhere. They became so popular because of their convenience and affordability. but are these the only features, or even the main ones, to consider in our use of them? The bitter truth remains that they are also one of the biggest sources of land pollution (you see them littering our streets and neighborhoods and filling our landfills with their chemicals) and water pollution (just think of the "plastic island" located in the Pacific Ocean the size of Texas) and climate change (single-use plastics are made from fossil fuel).

There are plenty of eco-friendly alternatives that can be used to avoid plastic in our lives. What is more, the number of alternatives is increasing each day! Be mindful that anything bad for the planet can never be good for us in the long run. For those who want to eliminate plastic from their lives, here are some suggestions:

- Bamboo cutlery instead of plastic utensils; Bamboo drink stirrers; Biodegradable plates and cups
- Reusable stainless steel, bamboo, or glass straws
- Biodegradable organic cotton bags to hold vegetables, other items; Mesh produce bags; Linen bread bags; Reusable, canvass shopping bags
- Glass or metal bottles instead of plastic ones
- Washable diapers
- Reusable sandwich and snack bags; Beeswax food wrap, Parchment paper in place of wax or plastic paper
- Rechargeable batteries; Wool dryer balls in the dryer
- Reusable coffee filters and pods
- Dishcloths instead of paper towels; Bar soaps instead of liquid; Conditioner bars; Bamboo toothbrushes
- Metal containers to carry leftover food home from restaurants
- Food storage in jars or silicone bags
- Wooden, bamboo, or glass cutting boards

It is these small plastic items, that as they accumulate, pollute our Earth more and more, contributing to the ever-growing threat of climate change. Our efforts and willingness to replace these small plastic products in our lifestyles will contribute to a healthy, thriving Earth.

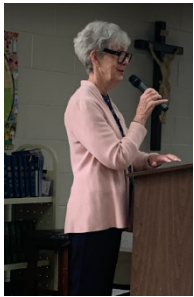

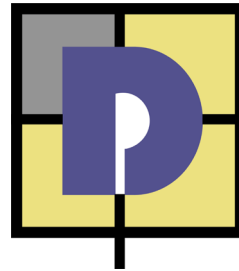

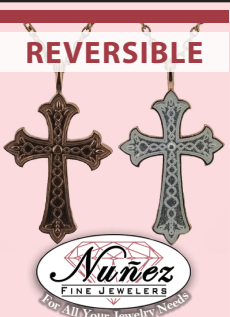
