"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

Hydrogen is turning up in movies and the headlines as the fuel of the future! Is hydrogen really the zero carbon fuel of our dreams? Its promise as a climate solution has piqued the interest of entrepreneurs, scientists, and governments. According to Mckinsey and Company, more than 680 new large-scale hydrogen projects have been announced around the world, representing \$240 billion in investments over the next decade.

The question arises, though: "Is hydrogen energy clean?" It does produce zero carbon emissions when it is burned or used in a fuel cell. However, pure hydrogen is rarely found in nature. It must be extracted from another source, and today almost all hydrogen is extracted from coal and natural gas, releasing carbon dioxide as a by-product.

There is promise in green hydrogen, which can be produced from water, using renewable energy. Today, however, less than 1% of hydrogen is green. Even green hydrogen isn't harmless. If burned, hydrogen creates nitrous oxides. These air pollutants can cause asthma, bronchitis, and increase the risk of heart disease, putting the health of people living and working near hydrogen facilities at risk. Also, another drawback is that "hydrogen is a leak-prone gas with a potent climate warming affect that is often overlooked," says the Environmental Defense Fund (EDF) scientist Ilissa Ocko. "If hydrogen is going to deliver what its backers promise, we need to keep it from escaping into the atmosphere." It is the small hydrogen leaks that need to be watched out for, because they can actually exacerbate global warming.

Hydrogen is an indirect green house gas.

What has been found is that when it leaks, it creates a chain of chemical reactions that increase the amount of greenhouse gases in our atmosphere. Until now, there has been no way to find small hydrogen leaks. Locating and measuring hydrogen leaks is fast becoming a critical issue.

Currently, for energy, hydrogen is used on a very small scale in buses, cars, and a handful of trains, trucks and homes.

In many cases, renewable electricity is far more efficient, affordable, and cleaner to use than hydrogen. EDF analysis shows that green electricity could power up to 16 times more homes and as many as 9 times more cars when it is used directly for these purposes.

Hydrogen can be a key tool to cut climate pollution – but its benefits are far from guaranteed at this point. It is going to take careful planning, more climate research, and leak detection rules and technologies to ensure that it delivers the climate benefits needed.

AFGHAN REFUGEE UPDATE

In December of 2022, Holy Family partnered with Commonwealth Catholic Charities to support and mentor six male Afghan refugees. We have journeyed together to find housing, employment, banking, driver licenses, medical care, cell phones, insurance and much more. Two of the men are no longer in Virginia Beach. Both had friends in other parts of the country. The other four remain in Virginia Beach and we continue to assist them. They are in different stages of obtaining asylum but all have applied for temporary protective status. All four of them have cars and are completely self-sufficient financially. Two men work in hotels and restaurants and one works repairing HVAC systems and the other one

recently got his CDL truck driving license. Thev miss their families and country dearly.


