#### "CREATION CARE CORNER:"

Through the Bible we know that our God has entrusted the care of our Earth to us humans. We are the caretakers privileged with the call to contribute to Her well-being and growth by the way we live.

I recently came across this amazing statement (see paragraph below), written by Dr. Mary Emily Duba of the University of Dubuque Theological Seminary:

"God's presence saturates creation. God is here! God is deep-down here, in/with/under the finite things of creation! God is in every earthly thing – in the grain, the grape, music, love, forgiveness. Our place is in God's presence." So, if our place, our common home – The Earth – is all in God's presence, then creation itself is the dwelling place of God! Caring for creation means protecting all wherein God is divinely "present."

How does this awareness impact your understanding of our role as creation caretakers? For me, it fortifies and affirms this privilege and responsibility! We would do well to spend some time reflecting on this awareness and determining to what extent it is the motivation prompting our actions and way of living.

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you have to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.


