Wedding Policy – **At least nine months** before the wedding, the couple should meet with the pastor, **before** the wedding dates are selected. At least one member of the family should be a member of our parish.

Baptism Policy – Parents must be registered parishioners and attend a Baptism Class before their child may be baptized. Expectant mothers are encouraged to attend. The class is for parents only – baby-sitting is not provided.

Funeral Policy – Funerals are scheduled Tuesday-Saturday. We discourage funerals Sundays and Mondays. Participation by other priests and deacons must have prior approval of current pastor.

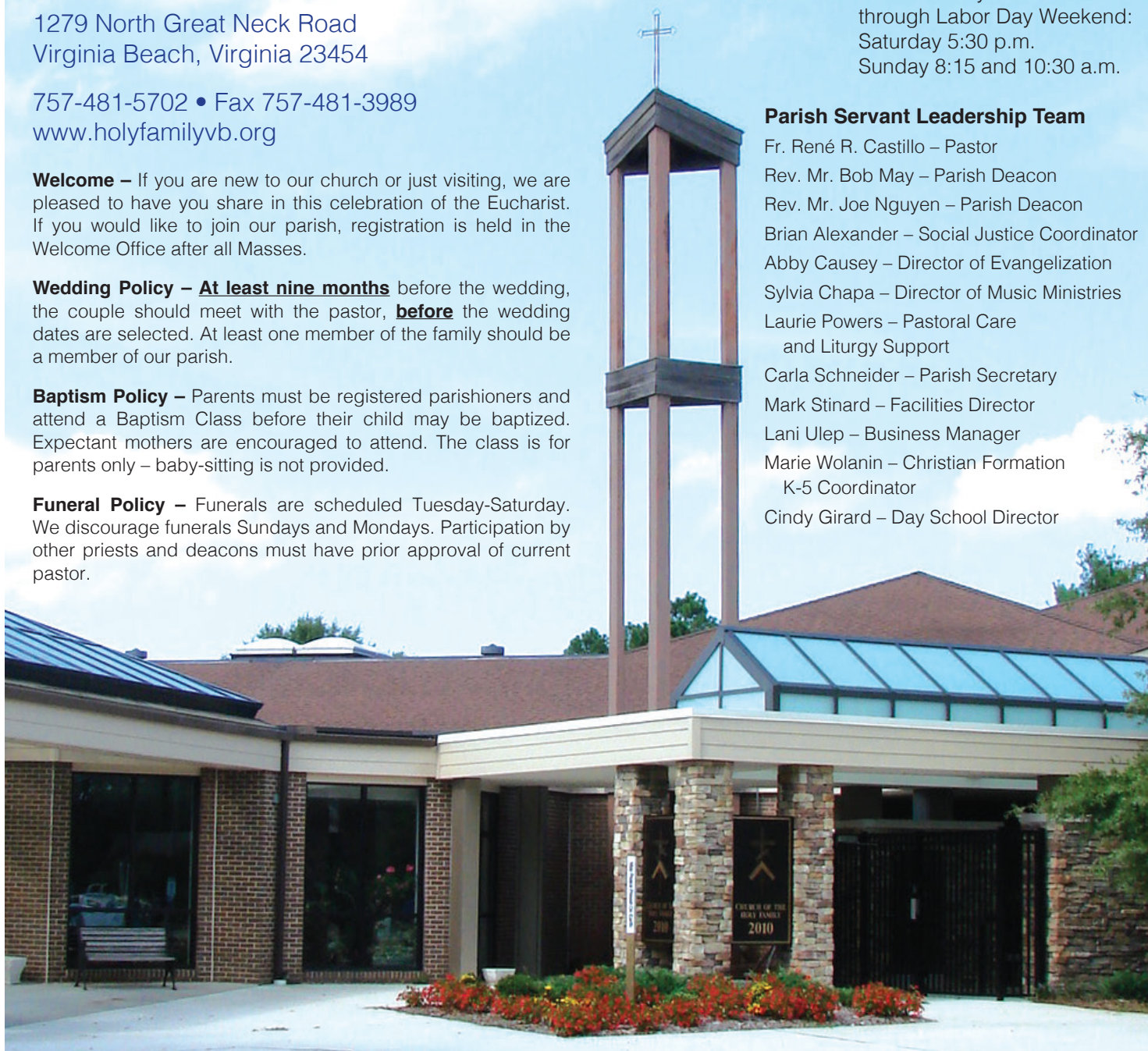

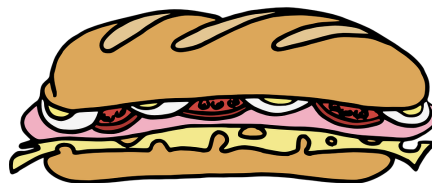

“CREATION CARE CORNER:”

Our oceans have great importance for the survival and well-being of our Earth. They are not only our life source, providing protein for more than 3 billion people in the world, but they also play a crucial role in regulating global climate by mediating temperatures, influencing weather patterns and acting as the world’s largest carbon sink. Oceans produce at least 50% of the planet’s oxygen, making its conservation literally a matter of life and death. Oceans, however, need our support.

With 90% of the fish population depleted and 50% of coral reefs destroyed, we are taking more from them than can be replenished. In honor of World Oceans Day 2023 which was on June 8, let’s take a look at various things we can do to protect this invaluable resource. We need to work together to create a new balance with the ocean that no longer depletes its bounty, but instead restores its vibrancy and brings it new life. The world’s population needs to be mobilized and united on a project for the sustainable management of the world’s oceans.

The UN Division for Ocean Affairs offers these important ways people can help protect it:

* Opt for plastic-free alternatives. We need to demand that companies provide plastic-free alternatives and dump single-use plastics like straws, plastic cutlery, coffee cups, water bottles, plastic bags, and take-out containers.

* Avoid products that harm the ocean – those that support unsustainable fishing and threaten important species and ecosystems. Avoid cosmetics that contain shark squalene, jewelry made of coral or sea turtle shell, souvenir shells of conchs, nautilus, and other sea animals.

* Eat sustainable seafood. Ideally, skip meat altogether and adopt completely plant-based diets, if feasible. If you do eat seafood, make sure that it is sustainable. For help in making these choices, these handy resources were created: ***Seafood Watch***, which aids you in choosing sustainable seafood; and *earth.org*’s top 5 Sustainable Plant-Based Seafood Companies.

* Support organizations working to protect the ocean. There are many organizations that are working to protect ocean habitats and marine life. Find one that resonates with you and consider giving financial support or, better yet, volunteering to work with them.

We need to reconnect with the ocean in a sustainable way to ensure that its benefits can be enjoyed for generations to come! This article was adapted from one in *earth.org*, “World Oceans Day 2023: Things You Can Do to Save the Ocean,” written June 8, 2023.

- Those adults who have been Baptized in a recognized non-Catholic Christian tradition
- Those adults who were Baptized Catholic but have not celebrated Eucharist and Communion

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you **have** to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.

Virginia Beach City Council Approves Group Home for Migrant Children at Former Seton House at St. Nicholas Catholic Church

Holy Family parishioner Kay Flohre spoke at the last City Council meeting in support of Commonwealth Catholic Charities operating a group home for unaccompanied migrant children. Other Holy Family parishioners who spoke in support were Abby Causey, Tim McCarthy, and Brian Alexander. City Council unanimously approved changes to permits to allow the former Seton House at St. Nicholas Church to provide services for unaccompanied minors for a maximum of sixty days. Commonwealth Catholic Charities has run a similar home in Richmond, Virginia, since 2019. City Council member of the 8th District, Chris Taylor said, "The right decision is to allow this applicant to move forward with their mission to help these children." Potential residents of the group home will come to Virginia Beach from an intake facility in Texas according to Commonwealth Catholic Charities.

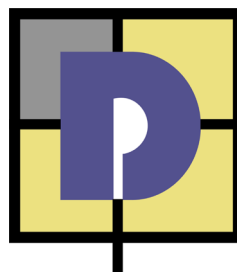
