

- Those adults who were baptized Catholic, but have not celebrated Eucharist and Communion

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you <u>have</u> to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.

### "CREATION CARE CORNER:"

last week's In article, we learned that Pope Francis is taking a strong stand in matters of climate change, urging governments, corporations, and people "to move away from the

throwaway culture towards ways of living, marked by a culture of respect and care; care for creation and care for neighbor whether they are near or far away."

In this article, we learn about the tirade the UN Secretary, General Antonio Guterres, launched against the fossil fuel industry during a key UN climate summit, held annually in Bonn, Germany, over its role in climate change, describing Big Oil companies' actions as "immoral" and calling on countries to develop a credible phase-out strategy. He accused the fossil fuel industry of being "at the heart of the climate crisis" and urged countries to boost investments in renewables. Guterres explained that "the problem is not simply fossil fuel emissions, it is fossil fuels – period," adding that they are "incompatible with human survival."

The UN head also attacked carbon capture technology, defined by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change as "anthropogenic activities that remove carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and store it durably in geological, terrestrial, or ocean reservoirs, or in products." Guterres said that any attempt to justify the fossil fuel expansion with carbon capture and storage technologies only makes companies "more efficient planet wreckers." The only feasible solution, he argues, is to phase out fossil fuels completely and instead reinvest the industry's massive profits in renewables and the green economy. While clean energy sources are being developed at record speed (a report by the International Energy Agency, published earlier this year, stated that clean energy is set to cover most of the new global electricity demand by 2025), fossil fuel consumption continues soaring. According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, CO2 levels peaked at 424 parts per million in May and now are more than double what they were before the onset of the Industrial Revolution in the 19th century. Here we have two globally, influential persons expressing the urgency and priority that the issue of climate change is calling on world leaders and corporations to deal with the very source of this pending calamity. Our actions on behalf of our Earth determine how seriously we take this pending disaster.




