

"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

SOIL - PART I

No matter where we are in the world, climate change is unfolding before our eyes. We are warming our planet at an unprecedented rate and, if left unchecked, the social, environmental, and economic consequences for our reckless actions will soon be irreversible. When

our planet.



it comes to climate change, discussions overwhelmingly focus on the fossil fuel industry. While there is enough scientific evidence to support the idea that oil and other planet-warming fuels are the main culprits, radical changes are equally needed across other sectors.

Among the too often overlooked topics is soil degradation. Why soil? Well, 52% of the planet's agricultural soil is degraded and, if business as usual continued through 2050, the United Nations projects additional degradation of an area almost the size of South America. Also, if we do not change our reckless practices and step up to preserve soil health, food security for billions of people will be irreversibly compromised, with an estimated 40% less food expected to be produced in 20 years' time, despite the world's population projected to reach 9.3 billion people. We need to understand that soil is a valuable resource for

This topic will be continued in next week's article. It is vital to understand the essential role that something as common as soil plays in the crisis of climate change and how necessary it is that we give thought and care to this resource.


