"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

SOIL - PART II

This topic is continued from last week's article. We need to understand that soil is a valuable resource for our planet for, at least, a couple of reasons.



Soil is the largest active store of carbon next to oceans,

holding more carbon than land vegetation and the atmosphere combined. This makes it a great asset in limiting global temperature rise and mitigating changes in our climate. Plants absorb CO2 from the air naturally and effectively through photosynthesis and part of this carbon is stored in the soil as soil organic carbon.

The problem arises when soil is plowed and exposed, as it effectively turns into a source of carbon. Sadhguru, a best-selling author and environmental advocate, and who initiated "Save Soil" (a movement to address the global soil crisis), has stated that "the worst thing one can do to the land is plow it and leave it open, because microbial life dies." All microbial activity sits in the first 12 to 15 inches of soil. As little as a handful of healthy soil can contain anything between 5 to 7 billion organisms. Nowadays, the issue is that machines are plowing 12 to 14 inches deep. Scraping the first layer of soil means leaving it exposed to harsh summer sunlight, which can rapidly kill all organisms in it.

Sadhguru has said that "soil is connected to human health, both in terms of physiological and psychological health and substantial studies today support this claim." Indeed, microbial life in the human gut is an essential factor for proper food digestion and nutrient absorption. For instance, a soil-based micro-organism, that can easily be found in edible plants is responsible for generating serotonin, a critical neurochemical that helps with mental balance and improves cognitive functions.

This topic will be continued in next week's article. It is vital to understand the essential role that something as common as soil plays in the crisis of climate change and how necessary it is that we give thought and care to this resource.



Interfaith Immigrant Legal Assistance Fund

The immigrant Legal Assistance Fund, founded in 2020, provides immigrants without legal status who reside in south Hampton Roads with financial assistance for their legal needs related to their immigration case, including immigration attorney fees and immigration case filling fees. Grants are available up to a maximum of \$500.




