PART-TIME EARLY CHILDHOOD AND OCIC COORDINATOR:

Church of the Holy Family seeks a part-time coordinator of Baptisms, CLOW (Children's Liturgy of the Word), Sunday Nursery, and OCIC (Order of Christian Initiation of Children).

Duties include overseeing our ongoing Baptismal preparation program, CLOW program during the school year, ongoing OCIC program, and establishment of a Sunday Nursery during the Masses. This coordinator will work under the supervision of the Director of Elementary Religious Education to carry out all responsibilities. This coordinator will work closely with families to provide information and facilitate their participation in all these programs. The coordinator will oversee, train, and recruit catechists to run effective and engaging Baptism, CLOW, Nursery, and OCIC programs. The coordinator will work with clergy and other staff to organize and administer programming. He or she will make sure that sacramental guidelines are followed and that necessary documentation for sacraments is collected and recorded.

Requirements include basic knowledge of Catholic sacramental theology, in particular the Sacraments of Initiation. The coordinator should have experience in sacramental formation and demonstrate pastoral skills and deep respect for cultural diversity. The coordinator will have strong communication skills with adults and children alike and be successful working in a team setting. The position also requires the ability to work independently. Given the position and its responsibilities in our parish, the coordinator needs to be a Catholic in good standing and must be VIRTUS trained or eligible for VIRTUS training.

ALTAR SERVER MINISTRY:



"THIS IS MY BODY"

The book, "This Is My Body: A Call to Eucharistic Revival," by Bishop Robert Barron, is available after Mass for a donation. It is an exceptional explanation of why we celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist as Catholics.

"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

In June, 2023, Greta Thunberg, the 20-year-old Swedish climate activist was arrested by the Swedish police in Malmo Harbor for her involvement in an anti-oil protest. Thunberg had joined a group of around 20 protesters from the Swedish group, "Reclaim the Future," at the city's oil terminal, climbing on tankers and blocking the entrance to the port, preventing trucks from entering or leaving the port. She was found guilty by a Swedish court of disobeying police orders to leave the anti-oil protest. She was fined what amounted to \$240 in U.S. money.

What is of special interest to us, were the various comments she and her group made. They point out the injustices that prevail in the climate change crisis.

Ms. Thunberg said in an *Instagram post* on the day she joined the protest: "The climate crisis is already a matter of life and death for countless people. We choose to not be bystanders, and instead physically stop the fossil fuel infrastructure. We are reclaiming the future."

The group's spokesperson said that "The real crime is inside the gates we blocked. We will continue our opposition to this type of activity. We are not going to wait and contribute to the fossil fuel industry continuing to take our dreams away from us."

In the trial, following the giving of the verdict, Greta said: "We know we can't save the world by following the rules, because the rules have to change."

She further commented: "We know that our laws are not designed to protect people long term but rather it seems more like they are to protect economic interests and destructive industries and companies."

The group behind the protest said in a *Twitter post*: "What if the media could put the same resources into exposing the fossil fuel companies' and those in power's betrayal of young people around the world."

According to the group, just hours after Thunberg's sentence announcement, she and 15 other young activists returned to the oil port for a new blockade.

Within the past 5 years, Thunberg and her army have made their voices heard, helped shape public opinion, and challenged world leaders to take immediate action in climate change mitigation.

Step 2: Once you sign-up you will receive directions on where and how to compost at Holy Family. You will also receive 10 compostable bags to get you started.


Step 3: Purchase a composting container for your kitchen and start collecting your food scraps.


